

# AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITIES OF GUJARAT

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURES FOR 1ST YEAR B.V.SC.& A.H. DEGREE COURSE**

1. The number of candidates to be admitted to the first Professional year of B.V.Sc.& A. H. programme in an Academic year shall be decided by the Anand Agricultural University keeping in view the infrastructure facilities specified under VCI Regulations. The present intake capacity of the college is 50 students + 15 % VCI Nominee + 15 NRI / Payment seats + 1 Student for Parsi Community.
2. The reservation of seats will be as per State Government and Anand Agricultural University policy laid down from time to time.
3. In respect of Gujarat State candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/the Scheduled Tribes or other special category of students as specified by the Government from time to time, marks required for admission shall be 10% less than that prescribed for General category. Where the seats reserved for Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes students in Gujarat State cannot be filled for want of requisite number of candidates fulfilling the minimum requirement prescribed from the state, then such vacancies shall be filled up on all India basis with students belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes getting not less than the minimum prescribed pass percentage.
4. The students educated abroad seeking admission in to Veterinary colleges in Gujarat must have passed the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English up to 12<sup>th</sup> standard level with 50% marks in theory in the individual subjects.
5. Students who have passed Std.-12<sup>th</sup> examination from other state can seek admission through Veterinary Council of India (VCI) New Delhi.
6. Admission of candidates to B.V.Sc.& A.H. degree course under bilateral exchange programme shall be regulated by Veterinary Council of India (VCI).
7. 15% of the total number of seats of each Veterinary College shall be reserved to be filled on an All India basis through Common Entrance Examination.(All India Pre- Veterinary Test) to be conducted by the Veterinary Council of India (VCI).
8. A candidates under General category for admission to the B.V.Sc.& A.H. degree course must have passed in each of the subjects of English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology with obtained 50% of marks in aggregate of these subjects at the qualifying examination of Standard- XII. The admission of the students to B.V.Sc.& A.H. degree course shall be made only on the basis of his/her merit in GUJCET-2010 examination. No other weight-age shall be considered for admission to the B.V.Sc.& A.H. degree course .

9. The Payment / NRI Seats -15 (Fifteen) in the College will be filled in as per AAU Rules. The NRI students need not to appear the entrance examination.
10. A candidate shall not be allowed admission B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course including those admitted under 15% reserved quota of Veterinary Council of India(VCI) if he/she suffers disabilities in Physical fitness as listed below.
  - a) disability of total body including disability of chest/spine more than 50%
  - b) disability of lower limb of more than 50%
  - c) disability of upper limb,
  - d) visually handicapped candidates and those with hearing disability,
  - e) Candidates with progressive diseases like myopathies etc.
  - f) disabilities which otherwise would interface in the performance of the duties of a veterinarian.
11. The disability should be certified by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board comprising of at least three specialist out of which two should be the specialty concerned and the candidate has to present him/her- self before Medical Board. The last valid disability certificate of the candidate from Medical Boards should not be more than three month old from the date of submitting his/her certificate for disabled candidates.
12. The candidates should have completed age of 17 years on or before December 31st of year of admission.
