

Veterinary Clinical Complex

Profile:

Veterinary Clinical Complex (VCC), College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, AAU, Anand is catering the need of Veterinary Education with expertise animal treatment services to the state. The undergraduate and the postgraduate students of the college get hands-on-training for treatment of various species of animals including the wild animals. This hospital is also a good source of research material for the postgraduate students as well as the researchers working in the field of Veterinary Science. The animals like dogs and horses of different district police head quarters, specialized dogs of the airports of the Gujarat, sniffer dogs of the CSIR, BSF and other national institutes get routine as well as expertise treatment under VCC. VCC has got very good indoor facilities, laboratory facilities and back up of other clinical departments of the college like Surgery, Medicine and Gynaecology in handling clinical cases. The staff members of VCC also provide expertise treatment under the field condition and also advisory services to the field Veterinarians.

During the last 10 years under Veterinary Clinical Complex a total of 138740 cases were given expertise treatment with yearly average of 13874. During the year 2015 from January to December 2015, a total of 16841 cases were treated under Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex (Zaveri Hospital). Out of total cases treated 9297 (55.20%) were freshly registered cases and rest were the repeat cases. The daily OPD case average in the hospital was 59.93 per working day during the year 2015. The species wise case distribution was: 5431 (58.41%), canines; 2502 (26.91%) caprine; 309 (3.32%) equine; 306 (3.29%) bovine; 177 (1.90%) bubaline; 105 (1.12 %) ovine; 31 (0.33%) cameline; 186 (2.00 %) avian; and 250 (2.68%) for other species.
