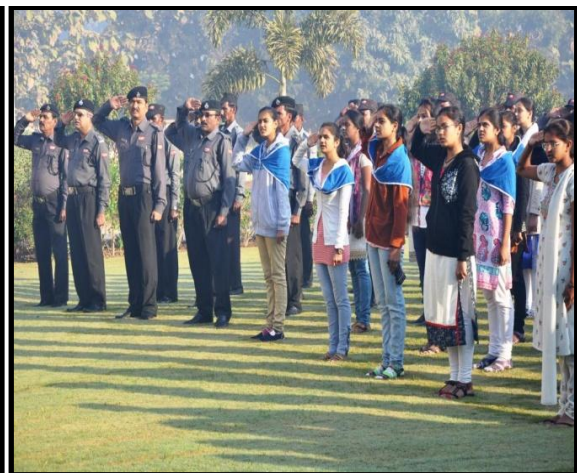
4.2 Celebration of Independence Day

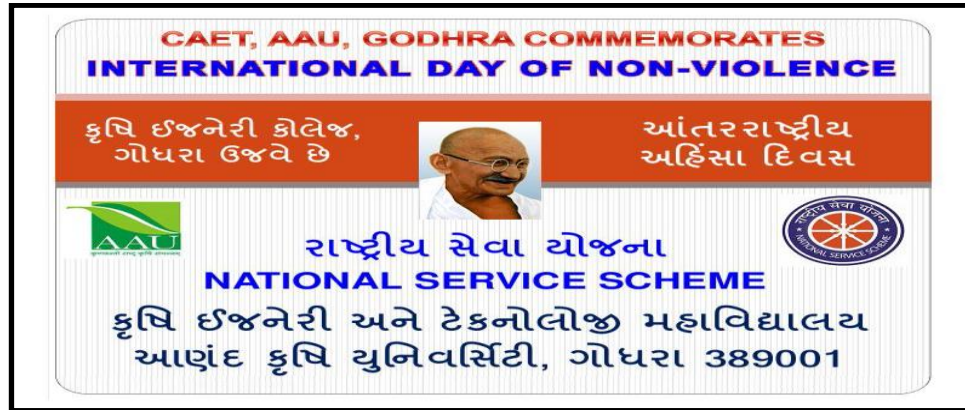


4.14 Lecture on “Bharat ne Jano Bharat ne Mano”

During the adventure camp, students have explored hilly regions of Himachal Pradesh, its locality, and biodiversity of flora and fauna. At the base camp, students did climbing and rippling on natural rocks as well as artificial rocks, river crossing, tracking and forest walks of 66 km and height gain of 10300 feet. They also gained an experience of living with minimum available resources – such as staying in the tent in an open surrounded area.
