
Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports organized a special Adventure Program for NSS volunteers at Dharamshala, Himachal Pradesh during 20th to 29th October, 2015. For this program, Directorate of Regional NSS office, Ahmedabad has selected 40 volunteers (i.e., university students) from Gujarat State. Of which 4 students from Anand Agricultural University has selected and they was: Kum. Shivani A. Bhanwadiya(BACA), Kum. Mansi Bhati (Horticulture wing), Mehul Prajapati (CAIT) and Rahul Nakum (FPTBE).

The Program has organized by Regional Mountaineering Centre, Meclodgunj, Dharamshala. Prior to the program, Instructors had provided basic information for Adventure Camp. During the adventure camp, students have explored hilly regions of Himachal Pradesh, its locality, and biodiversity of flora and fauna. At the base camp, students done climbing and rippling on natural rocks as well as artificial rocks, river crossing, tracking and forest walks of 66 km and height gain of 10300 feet. They also gained an experience of living with minimum available resources – such as staying in the tent in an open surrounded area.
