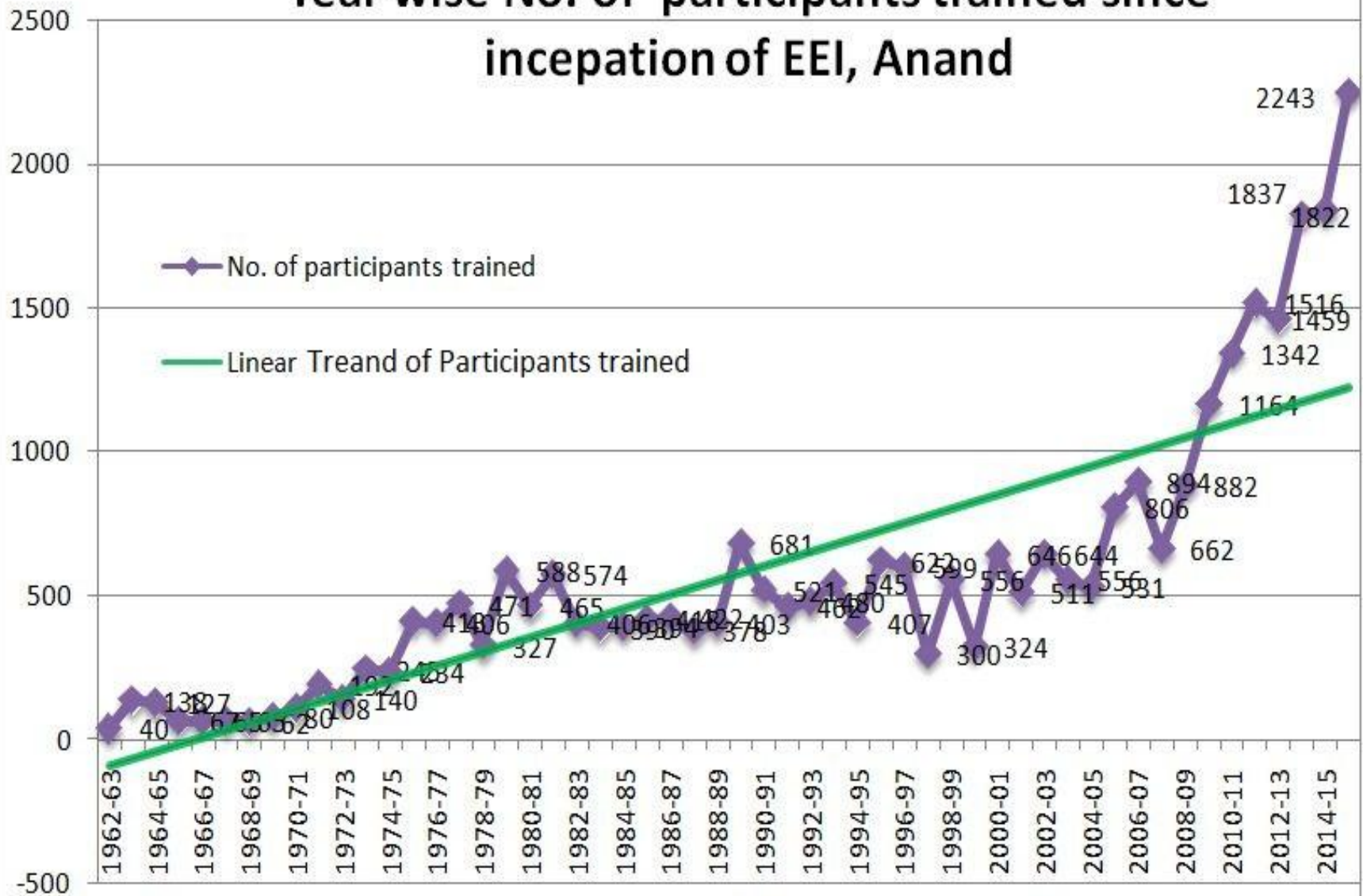

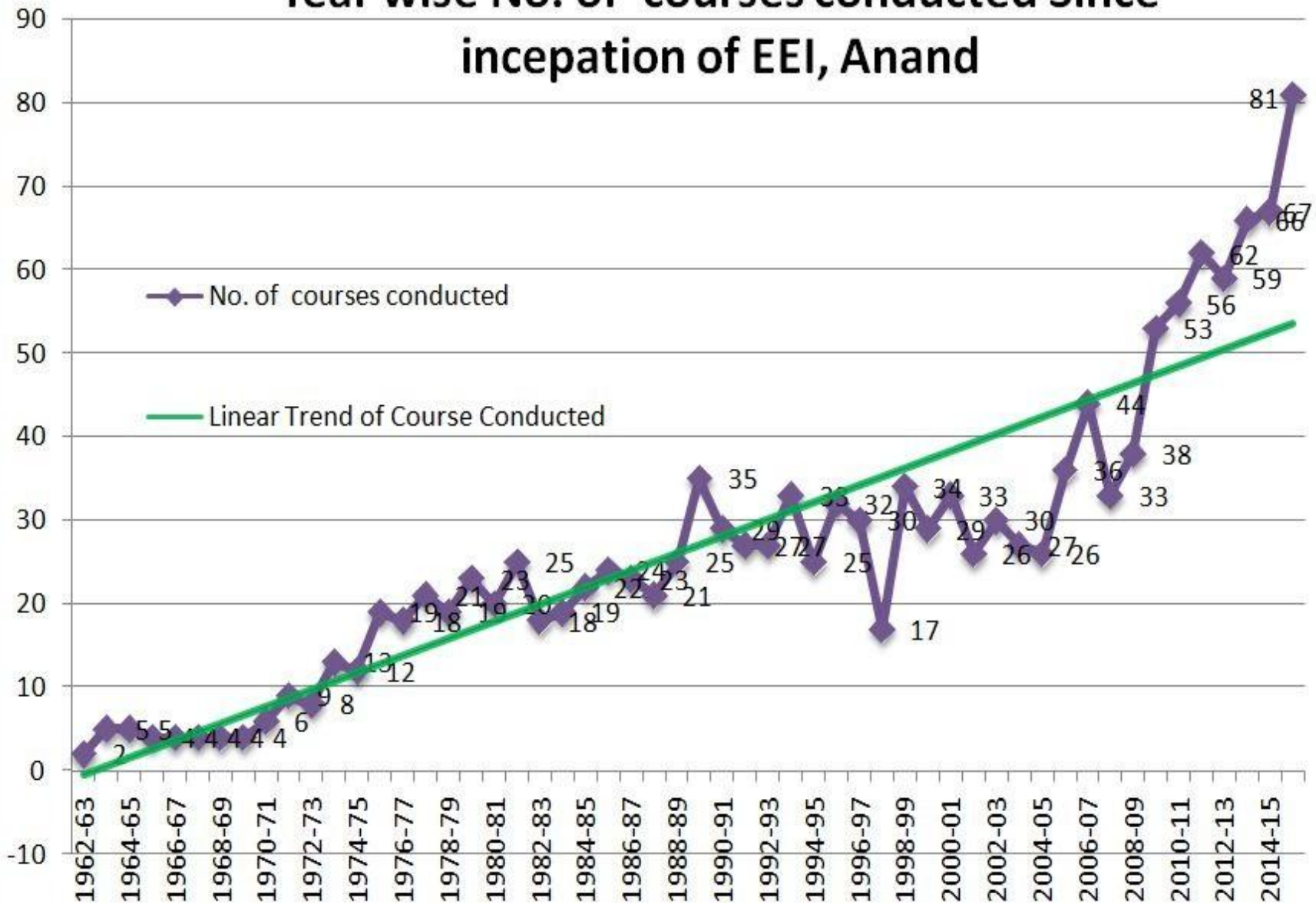
Growth of EEI

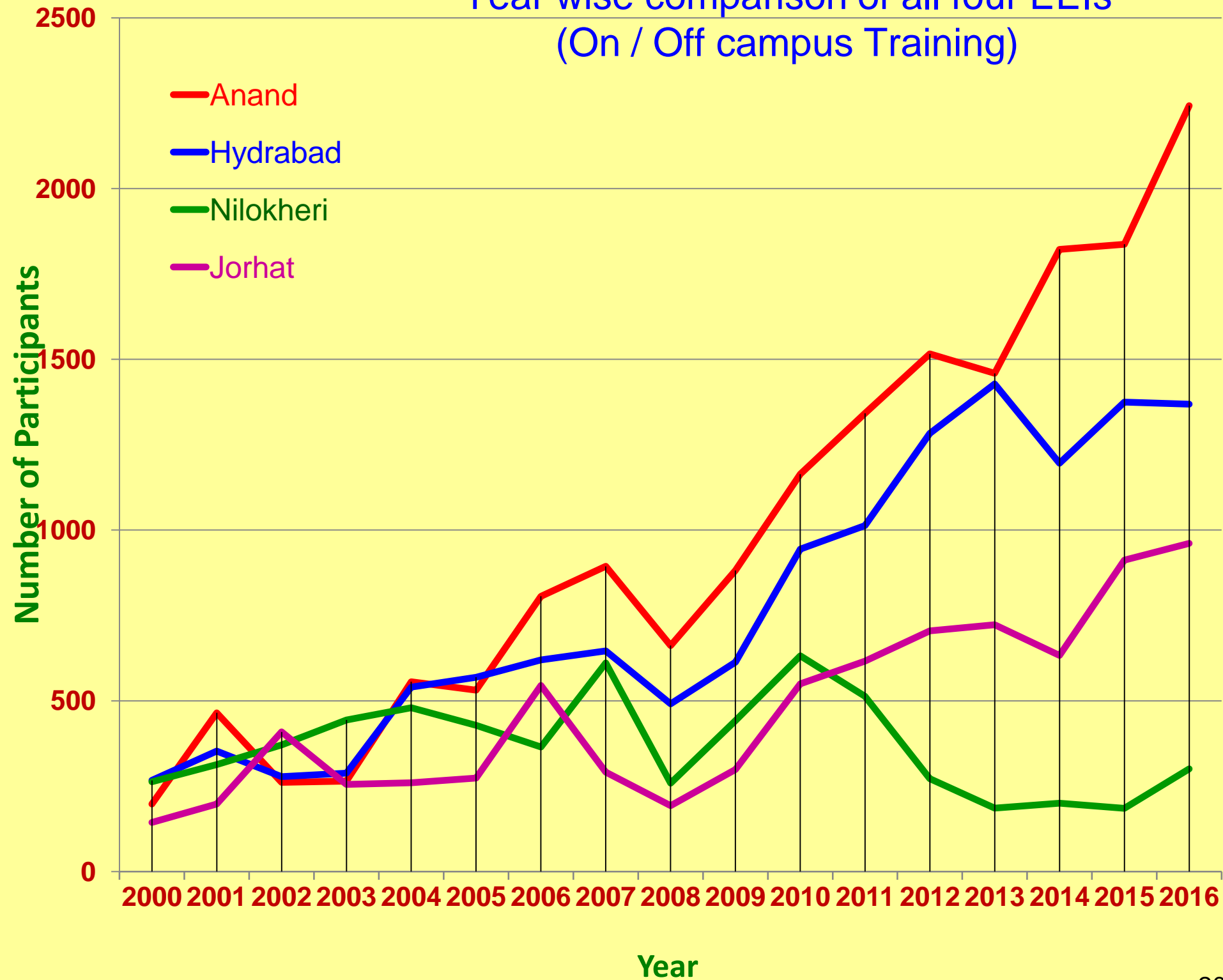




