

**REGULATIONS GOVERNING GAMES, SPORTS TOURNAMENTS, CULTURAL, LITERARY COMPETITIONS AND ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES FOR INTER-COLLEGE / INTER-POLYTECHNIC / INTER UNIVERSITY**

In exercise of the power vested in Section 20 (xxiv) of the Gujarat Agricultural Universities Act, 2004 (Gujarat Act No. 5 of 2004) the Academic Council approved the following Regulation, namely, "Common Regulations Governing Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competitions And Adventure Activities For Inter-College / Inter-Polytechnic /Inter University " in State Agricultural Universities" as recommended by Council of State Agricultural Universities (SAUs) in its 9th meeting vide Item No : 9.9 held on 08/04/2013 and recommended for the approval of Board of Management.

1.	"Regulations governing Games, Sports, Cultural, Literary Competition / Tournaments and Adventure Activities of the State Agricultural University "	<b>Title of the Rules</b>
1.1	These rules shall be called "Regulations governing Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competition and Adventure Activities for Inter-college / Inter-polytechnic / Inter -university " of the State Agricultural Universities.	
1.2	They shall come into force from the date of notification by superseding all previous rules.	
2.	In these rules, unless the context otherwise require,	<b>Definition</b>
2.1	<b>SPORTS</b> means an activity that is governed by a set of rules or customs and often engaged in competitively. Sports commonly refers to activities where the physical capabilities of the competitor are the sole or primary determinant of the outcome (winning or losing), but the term is also used to include activities such as mind sports and motor sports where mental acuity or equipment quality are major factors. Sport is commonly defined as an organized, competitive and skillful physical activity requiring commitment and fair play.	
2.2	<b>PLAYER/PARTICIPANT</b> means one that plays/performs, especially one who participates in Games, Sports Tournaments, Cultural, Literary Competition and Adventure Activities of the State Agricultural University.	
2.3	<b>TOURNAMENT</b> means a sporting competition in which contestants play a series of games to determine an overall winner.	
2.4	<b>INTER-COLLEGIATE</b> means competition taking place among different colleges (degree and polytechnic) of the university of the state.	
2.5	<b>INTER-UNIVERSITY</b> means competition taking place among different Universities of the state or the country.	
2.6	<b>COLLEGE</b> means a constituent college conducting degree or polytechnic programme in the state Agricultural Universities.	
2.7	<b>SPORTS COMMITTEE</b> means a committee of the Student Sports and Recreation. The Committee has to develop and implement strategies and policies to develop, encourage and coordinate sports activities across the institute.	
2.8	<b>REFEREE/ JUDGE</b> means a person who has authority to make decisions about play/performances in many sports/competitions.	
2.9	<b>COMPETITION</b> means an official participation in organized sport.	
2.10	<b>TEAM</b> means a number of persons associated together in any sports;

	Words and expressions used in these rules are not defined in these rules. The same meaning assigned to them in the GAU Act, 2004.	
<b>3.</b>	There shall be a committee consisting of the following to organize, control, manage and supervise various competitions/tournaments and students' welfare programme within the jurisdiction of the university and conduct inter-university sports tournament/competition.	<b>Sports Committee</b>
	i. Director of Students' Welfare - Chairman	
	ii. Chairman of the Students' Representative Council of all the constituent Colleges - Member	
	iii. Physical Instructors of all the constituent Colleges - Member	
<b>4.</b>		<b>Power/ Functions of the Sports Committee</b>
	The powers and functions of the sports committee shall be as follows:	
	i. To prepare its programme calendar, various games, sports, cultural and literary events, adventure programmes and its budget for presentation to the University.	
	ii. To decide University should participate in the several inter-university games and sports competitions.	
	iii. To appoint sub-committee if necessary, to select university team and to conduct inter-university games and sports competitions whenever the University is asked to do so by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), Inter Agricultural Universities Association (IAUA) or Council of State Agricultural Universities of Gujarat.	
	iv. To frame eligibility rules and general rules for sports and games, debate, extempore, essay, cultural competitions and other adventure programmes.	
	v. To settle dispute if any, among constituent colleges with regard to tournaments / competitions and other student activities within the jurisdiction of the sports committee.	
	vi. To take up such other programmes and activities within the jurisdiction of the sports committee as desired for the welfare of the students.	
<b>5.</b>		<b>Inter-collegiate / Inter-polytechnic Sports And Games Tournaments / competitions</b>
<b>5.1</b>	The method of the various tournaments / competitions shall be decided by the Committee.	
<b>5.2</b>	All the colleges shall inform the organizing college regarding their participation and shall submit the eligibility pro forma of the players before the commencement of the tournaments / competitions.	
<b>5.3</b>	A lots of the tournaments / competitions will be drawn in presence of all team managers and organizing secretary. The detailed programme of	

Director of Students Welfare, PAFS Agriculture University, Amritsar	the tournaments / competitions, will be decided by the organizing secretary.	
<b>5.4</b>	The Sports Committee shall allocate the responsibility to conduct the tournament / competition to any constituent college.	
<b>5.5</b>	The organizing college shall be responsible for its organization, supervision and conduct of the tournament / competition for this purpose. If required, the Principal of the organizing college shall appoint various committees. The chairman, Students' Representative Council shall be the organizing secretary. However, the overall responsibility of organizing the tournament / competition shall be of the Director of Students' Welfare and he/she may delegate his/her power to any one to whom he/she deems fit wishes to. The organizing secretary shall draw the detailed programme of the inter-college/polytechnic tournament / competition and send it to all participating colleges under intimation to the chairman, sports committee.	
<b>5.6</b>	It shall be the duty of organizing committee to ensure that all the rules and regulations laid down by the sports committee for the inter-college/polytechnic tournaments /competitions are fully observed and Game/tournament/competition is played fairly. In case, where a particular team has included ineligible player, as defined in the rules, the team shall be disqualified from the tournament after due verification. In case of the misconduct by any individual player(s) or a team as a whole, the organizing committee shall have power even to scratch the team/disqualify the individual player(s) from the tournament/competition. While doing so, whoever, the organizing committee shall strictly follow the procedure as laid down below:	
	<p>(a) Both the teams under dispute are given full opportunities to explain their respective points of view.</p> <p>(b) The Principal of the organizing college shall constitute committee of (1) Organizing Secretary (2) Physical Instructor (3) One expert of the game.</p> <p>(c) The matter is reported immediately to the Chairman, Sports Committee for information and further action if any.</p>	
<b>5.7</b>	The Organizing Secretary and Physical Instructor in consultation shall be empowered to select/appoint the competent referee/ official/judge for the tournament/competition.	
<b>5.8</b>	It shall be duty of the Organizing Secretary to inform the Chairman, Sports Committee regarding the tournament/competition and submit the copy of eligibility pro forma and result of the tournament/competition and the list of the selected team of the university.	
<b>5.9</b>	Each constituent college shall be entitled to send only one team for each tournament/competition.

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5.17	The participating college shall submit eligibility list of the players as per the pro forma send by the Director of Student's Welfare. Two copies of the same are to be submitted to the organizing college before the commencement of the tournament/competition.																															
5.18	The organizing college shall communicate the result along with the name of winners and runners up team to the Chairman, Sports Committee on the next day and a copy shall be sent to all the colleges.																															
5.19	If the match is not played due to any sound reasons like rain, it shall be played as per the rules of a particular game. The host college shall

<b>5.20</b>	Protest against the decision of referee/ umpire/judge or any other matter shall be lodged in writing within two hours of conclusion of the game/competition and depositing Rs. 200/- with the person in charge of the organizing college.	
<b>5.21</b>	If the protest is lodged prior to or during match, the match shall be played out. Teams, which abandon a match for any reason, shall be considered to have concerned it. Any team leaving field of play under protest shall be deemed to have loss the fixture and forfeited whenever a protest is not sustained. The Organizing Secretary shall send a report of any such incident to the Chairman, Sports Committee.	
<b>5.22</b>	<p>i. The University shall arrange for the trophies either from its own funds or from donation and those shall be the property of the University.</p> <p>The trophies for the game which are not regularly played shall be kept in the custody of the Chairman, Sports Committee. The college receiving running trophies shall hold themselves responsible for the safe custody and care of the trophies received.</p> <p>ii. All the trophies of inter-college/polytechnic tournament /competition shall be running (rolling) trophies and stock list of the trophies available for the award shall be maintained by the Chairman, Sports Committee.</p> <p>iii. There shall be one replica for each trophy, the replica shall be retained permanently by the winning college and shall be the property of the wining college.</p> <p>iv. Miniature trophy shall be awarded to those who are declared winners for three successive tournaments</p> <p>v. The college holding any of trophies shall return the same to the Chairman, Sports Committee at the time of the Annual Athletic Meet.</p>	
<b>5.23</b>	A certificate of merit shall be awarded to the individual member of the winning team in team games/competitions, weight lifting and individual athletic championship and to individual securing first and second places in athletics/gymnastics. For considering points; Winner/First place will be awarded 5 points and runner up/second place will be awarded 3 points in individual game.	
<b>5.24</b>	<p>i. Team Championship Trophies shall be awarded to the wining teams in each Team Games, Athletics, Gymnastic, Weight-lifting, Wrestling and Best Physique competitions. The winning team in Athletics and Gymnastic shall be the team which obtained the highest aggregate points arrived at by totaling the points obtained by all the competitors forming the team in Athletics or Gymnastics. The award of point being on the basis maintained in para-5.23 above.</p> <p>ii. There shall be an Overall General Championship Trophy which shall be awarded to the college obtaining the highest aggregate points won in Team Games and Athletics.</p> <p>iii. Winners in each team game and champions in each Athletics</p>

The university shall bear the expenses (Honorarium/Remuneration/T.A/D.A) on account of the allowances to the official of the tournament as under:</p> <p>(i) Maximum first class railway fare from their Native/Office to the place of tournament and back.</p> <p>(ii) Rs.250/- per day as D.A. for outsider senior officials and Rs. 175/- per day for outsider assistant officials.</p> <p>(iii) Rs.150/- per day shall be paid as D.A. and convenience allowance to the local senior officials and Rs.100/- to local assistant officials.</p>

<b>6.</b>		
<b>6.1</b>	The University may participate in the inter-university tournaments / competitions/Yuva Mahotsav etc. as may be decided by the Sports Committee.	<b>Inter – university tournaments/ competitions</b>
<b>6.2</b>	The selection of the university team or participants shall be made on the basis of performance in the inter-collegiate tournaments/competitions.	
<b>6.3</b>	The selection committee for the selection of university team shall be as under : (i) Physical Instructor/s (ii) Chief Referees  If the teams/participants are not selected by selection committee, the Chairman, Sports Committee is empowered to select the same to represent the university.	
<b>6.4</b>	The Chairman, Sports Committee may assign any staff member as team manager who will be overall responsible for the participation in the tournament/competition.	
<b>6.5</b>	The annual subscription for the membership of the concerned association shall be paid by the university every year.	
<b>6.6</b>	The University shall bear the cost of Rs. 400/- per participant as dress allowance for each tournament/competition.	
<b>6.7</b>	(i) The university shall bear the expenditure for track-suit of maximum cost of Rs.1200/- for all the participants. The track – suit shall be given to the player only once in one degree programme at the university.  (ii) The university shall bear the expenditure for track-suit of maximum cost of Rs.1200/- for the Team Manager.	
<b>6.8</b>	The university shall bear the second class railway fare with reservation/state or private bus traveling charges or the diesel, oil, R.T.O/toll taxes, expenses of the university vehicles.	
<b>6.9</b>	The participants are entitled to get D.A. at the rate of Rs. 250/- per day for the tournament/competition conducted outside the state and Rs.175/- per day for the tournament /competition conducted within the state.	
<b>6.10</b>	The university will provide T.A. and D.A. to the player/participant for coaching camp at the rates of the rules of the inter-collegiate tournament/competition.	
<b>6.11</b>	The university shall provide the equipment, ground facility <i>etc.</i> required for coaching camp.	
<b>6.12</b>	The university shall bear the cost of officiating charges, equipment charges or other charges of the tournaments/competitions.	
<b>6.13</b>	University may appoint a coach for advance training to the university team. He / She shall be entitled to get T.A. and D.A. as well as Honorarium as per rules for the officials of inter collegiate tournament /competition.	
<b>6.14</b>	Petty expenditure for refreshing item such as glucose, lemon, ice-

<b>6.15</b>	In case of sickness or physical injury to the player/participant, during the actual game/competition/coaching camp at the time of inter-college and inter-university competition the cost of medical treatment of the player/participant shall be borne by the University.
