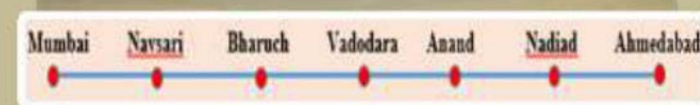

About Anand:

Anand is known as the Milk Capital of India. It is famous for Amul dairy. The city hosts, inter alia, Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation, National Dairy Development Board, well known management institute-IRMA and Anand Agricultural University. Other well-known product of the city is Vallabh Vidyanagar, an educational hub of Gujarat.

Winter approaches Anand in November and lasts till February. During this period the climate is pleasantly cool and the temperature ranges from 10°C to 26°C. Summers of Anand, March to June, are hot as temperature during this period ranges from 32°C to 44°C. Anand lies between Ahmedabad (70 km away) and Vadodara (45 km away) on the western railway. The National Express way-1, between Ahmedabad and Vadodara, also passes through Anand.



About the Training:

International Agribusiness Management Institute, AAU, came into existence in 2008. The institute offers two years master of Business Administration with a core focus on agribusiness and international trade. 10. ICT and agricultural trade.
11. Promotion of Agricultural Export
12. Quality: Key for international trade in agriculture.
13. Getting started in international trade.

Eligibility:

The training programme has been sponsored by ICAR, New Delhi. The training course is designed for faculty and scientists (Assistant Professor and above) and will be for a duration of ten days from 19th – 28th January, 2015. The candidate should be sponsored by his/her organization.

Travel & Accommodation:

The selected candidate will be provided suitable boarding & lodging and up to II Tier AC Train fare for ‘To and Fro’ journey by the shortest route.
