BETWEEN

The Assam Agricultural University, (AAU-Jorhat) represented by its Vice Chancellor, having its office at Jorhat, Assam in India hereinafter referred to as the PARTY OF THE FIRST PART

AND

Anand Agricultural University (AAU-Anand) represented by its Vice Chancellor having its head quarter at Anand, Gujarat in India hereafter referred to as the PARTY OF THE SECOND PART

WITNESS that

WHEREAS, THE Party of the First Part is an education institution of national importance engaged in advancement of teaching, research and extension activities in various fields of agriculture and allied sciences.

WHEREAS, THE Party of the Second Part is, an educational institution of national importance engaged in advancement of teaching, research and extension activities in various fields of agriculture and allied sciences.

WHEREAS, both party of the First Part and the party of the Second Part have come to an understanding to promote teaching, research, extension and e-governance.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS.

1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE INCLUDING OBJECTIVES

- a. To promote students' and faculty exchange
- b. To collaborate research and extension education $\frac{1}{2} \frac{1}{2} \frac$
- c. To exchange software and expertise in the area of e-governance
- d. To undertake joint staff development programmes
- 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS
 - This MoU is valid for a period of five years at the first instance, but can be extended with the consent of both the parties.
 - This MoU shall be deemed to have been automatically rescinded after the public it expiry of the MoU period, unless renewed for any further period as per mutually agreed upon terms at a later stage.
 - 3. Either of the parties hereto shall be entitled to terminate the MoU at any time with valid reasons acceptable in writing to both the parties and in such case, the MoU will terminate six months after the date of written notification or date of expiry of the MoU, whichever is earlier. In case of such premature termination of the MoU, all rights and obligations of both parties shall automatically cease except for those covered by written contract including ongoing collaborative activity that can no longer be cancelled.
 - 4. In case of any dispute that may crop-up during executing of MoU, the matter would be settled through arbitration by referring to Aribitration

Committee comprising of a member nominated each by two parties and one member will be jointly nominated by two parties.

- 5. All credits and benefits for collaborative work including the intellectual property generated during the tenancy of project would be equally shared between both parties i.e. both parties shall be the joint owners of this IP.
- The collaborative programme between two parties shall be coordinated by a Coordination Committee consisting of one member from each organization nominated by Registrar, AAU, Jorhat and Director of Research and Dean, P. G. Studies, AAU, Anand.
- 7. The decision regarding patenting of the technology developed shall be taken jointly by the Co-ordination Committee. In case the technology developed is to be patented, the cost of patent and benefits accrued shall be shared keeping in view of both the parties and ICAR guidelines. Rights pertaining to third party, if any, will be decided jointly by the first two parties. Rights for commercialization shall rest jointly with both the parties and shall be decided by Co-ordination Committee. In case of involvement of private sector, decision will be taken through joint consultation and keeping in view guidelines of both the parties and ICAR.

Preamble:

The need of close co-operation in research and academic activities between State Agricultural Universities and ICAR Institutes has been realized by ICAR Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI) and Anand Agricultural University (AAU), Anand have been collaborating in various areas of academic activities common to these institutions for couple of years. To formalize the co-operation, it has been agreed to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Indian Veterinary Research Institute (IVRI), Izatnagar and Anand Agricultural University (AAU), Anand and the MoU will be subject to the following terms and conditions between IVRI and AAU.

1. General Terms & Conditions:

It is agreed that the collaboration between IVRI and AAU be established in the area of mutual interest to both the institutions for teaching and guiding research scholars leading to postgraduate (M.V.Sc. and Ph.D.) degrees. Accordingly, all the in service students of AAU studying at IVRI or IVRI students later on as faculty of AAU should undertake their research work at either in IVRI or AAU in the area of mutual interest of both the Institutes under the supervision of Advisor/Co-guide.

The said institute (IVRI, Izatnagar) agrees to make available infrastructure, laboratory facilities and subject specialist for academics and research of the postgraduate students.

- AAU agrees to extend its infrastructure, laboratory, library facilities and Animal Experimentation to scientists/research workers of the IVRI for accomplishing collaborative/joint teaching/research programme.
- 4. AAU agrees to extend facilities for field trials for the products developed by IVRI.

- 5. The MoU does not have any provision of common admission and the admission of students to the course of study shall be governed by the procedures of the respective Institutions.
- 6. The technical programme of research of all the students will be decided by the Advisory committee in consultation with the Co-guide/Major Guide of IVRI and AAU as the case may be.
- 7. For guiding postgraduate student as a major advisor or co-guide in case of aforementioned joint programme, staff members of the IVRI and AAU shall be accredited as teaching faculty of each other Institute.
- 8. The programme of research duly approved by the Dean, postgraduate studies and Joint Director (Academic) pertaining to partial fulfillment of said degree shall be termed as joint programme.
 - Such a staff member shall abide by the Academic Regulation of the IVRI/AAU, the concerned HOD shall ensure observance of the Academic Regulation of the other Institute.
- 10. Consumable Items (Chemicals, reagents, glassware, etc.) that shall be required for the research programme of the students shall be procured by the concerned HOD or the students themselves if not available in the institute.
- 11. For components of the teaching programme that require maintenance of academic record (attendance, conduct of examination, marks, submission of results, etc.) of students, the concerned scientists shall ensure to maintain and submit the required records as per academic calendar and schedule of teaching programmes of each other institutes.
- 12. The number of students from IVRI and AAU to be accommodated under the MoU will be decided by the concerned HODs depending on the available facilities in the University/Institute and technical programme of the students.
- 13. The students will be bounded by the rules and regulations of both the institutes from time to time.
- 14 Emergence of any intellectual property issue/publications from the joint research shall be dealt by both the institutions on equal sharing basis between IVRI and AAU as per guideline of ICAR, New Delhi.
- 15. The implementation and regulation of MoU shall be monitored and discussed by the Vice Chancellor, AAU and Director/Head/Incharge of the collaborating institution from time to time and any interim modification/alternation that may be necessary shall be brought into force.
