
NOTIFICATION

Annexure-I

ANAND AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY BEST TEACHER AWARD IN AGRICULTURAL HIGHER EDUCATION

To provide incentive and encouragement for good teaching and to recognize outstanding teachers at the university level, one Best Teacher Award will be given every year for an excellent teaching performance amongst all faculties of ICAR accredited colleges.

Name of the Award : Best Teacher Award in Agricultural Higher Education

The award will be presented to one faculty member among all the faculties of ICAR accredited colleges of Anand Agricultural University. The award is primarily meant for individual teacher independently teaching a course or part of an integrated course.

Nature of Award

The Best Teacher Award shall be annual. This award will be instituted by Anand Agricultural University subject to the availability of the fund from the ICAR.

Administration of the Award

The award in each Higher Agricultural Education Institute (HAEI) will be coordinated by Dean (PG Studies). The application form will be invited by the Coordinator, which will be submitted through HoD/Principal to the Principal/Dean. The Dean of the Colleges after having nomination from different departments as per **Annexure-II**, will forward one name to the Coordinator. The Coordinator will receive the nomination from all Deans. Thereafter, all nominations will be submitted to the Judgment Committee for its final recommendation. The Vice Chancellor will approve one name recommended by the Judgment Committee.

Academic year

Academic year will be considered from August to July of respective year.

Eligibility of the Award

The applicant must have at least 5 years of teaching/research/extension experience as a regular faculty member in Higher Agricultural Education Institute (including ICAR accredited SAUs) barring Principal/Deans. The applications/proposals will be invited by the Coordinator every year. The application/proposals in prescribed format will be enrooted through proper channel. It will be signed by the candidate and endorsed by at least three passed out postgraduate students and two peers from the Higher Agricultural Education Institute. **The work done during the past 5 years only will be considered for the award.** The candidate once selected for the award will not be eligible for the award for the next five years.

The candidate must have at least three 'Very Good' but not less than two 'Good' overall rating in annual appraisal/self-appraisal reports out of immediate past five reports. If the candidate's services include services of other University/ICAR or other recognized institute for some of the years, the self-appraisal evaluation will be considered as 'Good' or the actual if produced by the candidate. The candidate is expected to be a role model teacher with high moral values and must not have been penalized or any enquiry pending against him/her.

The judgment committee will be as follows

Presentation of Awards

The Best Teacher Award in Agricultural Higher Education shall be included certificate/citation with a cheque of Rs. 50,000/- as Cash Prize. It will be awarded during the immediate Annual Convocation of the University.
