The AAU Microbiologists Dr Rajababu V vyas and Mrs. Harsha N. Shelat developed Biofertilizers consortium that increase cereal yield by the seed and soil application at the time of sowing followed by foliar spray of Metabolite at 45 DAS/DATP . This resulted in a 25% drop in N & P chemical fertilizers use and the cost of cultivation.
