

## National Cadet Corps (N.C.C.)

### (i) For Boys Cadet:

It is a voluntary organization helping India in nation-building. The camps organized play a vital role in national integration through interaction among different caste, creed and culture. With a view to giving a boost to the youth in the positive direction, NCC has been included in the course curriculum. The NCC unit of BACA is attached with 4 Gujarat Battalion, NCC, Vallabh Vidyanagar. The unit consists of two platoons of 100 cadets. This year 4 Gujarat Battalion (Boys) organized Combined Annual Training Camps at Thamna. 65 cadets attended CATC camp. During CATC camp the cadets participated in different activities like weapon training, obstacle, map reading, essay writing, Volleyball competition and tug-of-war.

- During CATC Thamna cadets got first prize in various competitions like dance, anchoring, singing, best cadet and camp senior and other group senior.
- 09 cadets participated in Army attachment camp at Gandhinagar and Ahmedabad.
- 09 cadets participated in 'Ek Bharat Shresth Bharat' camp at Junagadh and achieved first place in NIAP and painting competitions.
- 43 cadets passed B certificate examination with A and B Grade in the year 2018-19.
- 14 cadets passed C certificate examination. 3 cadets got 'A' grade and 11 cadets got 'B' Grade in the year 2018-19.

### **(ii) For Girls Cadet:**

National Cadet Corps is a Tri-Services Organization comprising the Army, Navy and Air Force, engaged in grooming the youth – ‘The Leaders of Tomorrow’ – into disciplined and patriotic citizens. The genesis of the NCC can be traced back to the First World War when the Britishers created the University Corps as the second line of defense and to have a large pool of trained youth available for employment into the Armed Forces. Various training camps in NCC provide platform to the cadets to experience the activities carried out in defense. Anand Agricultural University is providing equal opportunities for all students to explore their capabilities in all possible ways.

NCC Girls unit was started in October 2017 under 4 GUJ Girls Battalion of V.V. Nagar Group with 32 Girl Cadets enrolled in first year and 33 girl cadets enrolled in 2018-19. Total strength of first and second year is 64 cadets from all the colleges of AAU. Throughout the year following activities were conducted.

#### **1) Rifle Shooting**

16 Cadets participated in ‘Rifle Training’ organized by the BN during May 03-05, 2018.

#### **2) Combined Annual Training Camp**

25 Girl Cadets participated in Combined Annual Training camp (CATC) for 10 days (July 02-11, 2018) at Thamna, Anand. They participated in various activities of rifle shooting, map reading, cultural activities.

#### **3) Army Attachment Camp**

8 NCC Girl cadets along with Lt. R.B. Dave of B. A. College of Agriculture attended 14 days (September 04-17, 2018) Army Attachment camp with 3<sup>rd</sup> BN of 1<sup>st</sup> Gorkha Rifles (3/1GR) at Army cantonment Area, Chiloda, Gandhinagar, Gujarat. Total 30 Girl cadets from various NCC groups of Gujarat participated in the camp. Cadets participated in weapon training, map reading, tent pitching, rifle shooting by INSAS and LMG rifles, Ambush demo, night navigation, point to point march, drill, first Aid training, adventurous activities like slithering, rappelling, artificial rock climbing.

#### 4) **Tree Plantation:**

National Cadet Corps trains the youth for Unity, Discipline and Leadership and also inspires the youth for their duty towards society by social service. 47 NCC Girl cadets from BACA, FPT, AIT and Horticulture colleges participated in Tree Plantation Programme organized by 4 Gujarat Girls BN, NCC, Anand of B. Akbari, Director of Students Welfare, AAU, Anand, Dr. J.S. Patel, Associate Professor, Dept. of Horticulture, BACA, Lt. R. B. Dave, ANO, NCC (Girls), BACA whole-heartedly participated in the programme to encourage cadets.

#### 5) **Lecture on Women empowerment**

Women Empowerment programme was organized by NCC (Girls), 4 Gujarat Girls BN of Anand Agricultural University, Anand in collaboration with Sardar Valabhbbhai Patel High School, Khetiwadi, Anand on 24/11/2018 at 3:00 pm at Sardar Patel School, Anand.
