They are also inspired to work with Environment, Health, Family welfare, Hospitals and other organizations during natural calamity for the benefit of society and work with people in the village and slums.

The social activities carried out by N.S.S. are divided in two groups.

4.(A) Regular activities

The regular activities carried out by this university during the year includes:-

4.1 68th Independence Day

Anand Agricultural University celebrated 68th Independence Day on 15th August 2014 at University Bhavan.

Dr.N.C.Patel, Vice-Chancellor of University & Chief guest of the celebration hoisted the flag & saluted it. In his speech he remembered Mahatma Gandhi & Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel for their great contribution in freedom fight and bringing independence to our nation which was started in 1857. Mahatma Gandhi used the weapons of non-violence movement & satyagraha and gave freedom to India from Britishers on 15th August-1947. He also appealed the students & staff for their maximum efforts in brining fame of the university by serving the farm communities.

All University Officers, Staff, Students, NSS Volunteers & all Security Guards remained present to grace this yearly celebration.



4.2 66th Republic Day

4.3 Tree Plantation and Environment Protection

- (4) College of Agricultural Engineering Technology, Godhra camp on 17/09/ 2015, 40 Units of blood were collected and donated by the students.



4.5 World AIDS Day
