Startups in technology sectors are an important economical indicator of technological performance of the country. Formation of new firms that focus on the development and introduction of new technology is a major source of innovation and technological advancement. Many of these Startups transfer new knowledge or new ideas into products and processes into commercial applications. Startups are likely to

bring in new solutions to the challenges faced by individuals/ companies that enter these new markets.

In view of this, Government of India has launched 'Startup India', a flagship initiative, intended to build a strong platform for nurturing innovation and Startups in the country that will drive sustainable economic growth and generate large scale employment opportunities. The Government through this initiative aims to empower Startups to grow through innovation and design. Government of Gujarat has also developed a policy for providing assistance to Startups/ Innovation. Under this scheme, any individual/group of individuals having innovative idea/concept will be eligible and/or Universities/education institutions, Incubation Centre/PSUs/R&D Institutions/ Private and other establishments will be eligible as an institution to support and mentor to innovators as approved by the designated Committee.

Anand Agricultural University has been nominated by Government of Gujarat as Nodal Institute for its Start Ups Support Scheme. As the Nodal Institute, AAU has initiated various activities to motivate the innovators and select Startups and mentor them through incubation centres. Under this scheme, the following assistance will be provided:

- ₹ 10,000/- per month will be provided to the innovator as sustenance allowance for one year whose project is recommended and approved by institution's Screening Committee.
- Up to ₹5 lakhs assistance will be provided to the institution for mentoring service annually.
- Up to ₹ 10 lakhs assistance will be provided for cost of raw material/components & other related equipments required for the innovative process for the new product development based on approval of the Screening Committee.
- Institution will support to the innovator by providing mentor services.
  - Institution will allow the innovator to use facilities available in the institution for Startups.

Kheda) by Anand Agricultural University in collaboration with district administration, Kheda and Dept. of Agriculture, Co-operation and Farmers Welfare, GoG, Gandhinagar.



The Hon. Chief Minister has also inaugurated the Agricultural Exhibition arranged with 100 stalls related to agricultural and allied fields of which 30 stalls were displayed by AAU, Anand demonstrating research and development activities as well as new technologies developed by the University. The Agricultural Exhibition was kept open for a day for the farmers. The farmers interacted directly with the scientists to solve their quarries and problems. The university also displayed its district specific technologies at other four places of Central Gujarat by arranging 30 stalls.

## AAU RANKED IN TOP 100 INSTITUTIONS OF INDIA

The National Institutional ranking Framework Report- 2017 has been declared by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), Government of India. The educational institutes/ universities have been ranked on the basis of different parameters. The main parameters which determinate ranking such as Professors; Qualifications and Quality; Research carried out in university; University publications and Students quality. At National level, in top 100 ranking institutions, only three found place from Gujarat, viz., Anand Agricultural University rank at 62<sup>nd</sup> position, IIM, Ahmedabad ranked at 17<sup>th</sup>, whereas IIT, Gandhinagar ranked at 78<sup>th</sup> position.



While in the category-universities, the Anand Agricultural University ranked in top 100 universities of India securing 40th position, which is a matter of pride for Gujarat State. Hon'ble President of India presided over the function held on 10 April 2017 at Rashtrapati Bhavan organized by MHRD. In the said event, Dr. N. C. Patel, Hon. Vice Chancellor and Dr. M. N. Brahmbhatt, Registrar of the university remained present and received Award and certificate for the same.


## DR M.D. PATEL e- LIBRARY IS ZOOMING INTO THE e-ERA

Dr M.D. Patel e- Library is zooming into the e-era further with the adoption of Koha software, the world's first free and open source Library system, fully featured and scalable for Library management. Earlier the Library was operating with Libsys software.

Koha is web-based ILS, with a SQL database (MySQL preferred), backend with cataloguing data stored in MARC and accessible via Z39.50 or SRU. The user interface is very configurable and adaptable and has been translated into many languages. Koha has most of the features that would be expected in an ILS, including:

- Various <u>Web 2.0</u> facilities like tagging, comment, Social sharing and <u>RSS feeds</u>
- Union catalog facility
- Customizable search
- Circulation and borrower management
- Reporting
- Off-line Circulation
- On-line Circulation

Presently, all the Library activities like accession, check-in, check-out and Library catalogue are all being managed with Koha.
