

TRAINING ON SCIENTIFIC CULTIVATION OF TOBACCO

Bidi Tobacco Research Station, Anand Agricultural University, Anand organized a training on Scientific Cultivation of Tobacco for the Technical Staff of Nisol Manufacturing Company Ltd., Dharmaj on 15th September 2021. The training programme was inaugurated by the Hon. Vice Chancellor, Dr K. B. Kathiria, Director of Research, Dr. M. K. Jhala, Director of Extension Education, Dr. H. B. Patel along with Unit Head, Dr. J. N. Patel and Managing Director of Nisol Company Ltd. Shri Ashish Patel. Hon. Vice Chancellor, Dr. K. B. Kathiria appreciated the effort carried out by the centre and also highlighted Public Private Partnership (PPP) by the University. Director of Research and Dean PG studies, Dr. M. K. Jhala encouraged scientists and emphasised that this type of collaboration may also help filed research PG students. Director of Extension Education, Dr. H. B. Patel pointed out that Bidi Tobacco is a major crop of Middle Gujarat and this type of training will definitely be helpful in scientific cultivation of tobacco by the farmers. Sri Ashish Patel narrated that scientific training leads to sustainable and quality production of tobacco.

The participants were trained by different scientists of Bidi Tobacco Research Station viz, Dr. J. N. Patel, Dr. K. M. Gediya, Dr. Y. M. Rojasara, Shri D. R. Delvadiya and Shri N. A. Bhatt. The trainees were trained on technical aspects of preparing nursery and field for healthy growth of tobacco. They were also given exposure on identification and management of different diseases and pests attacking tobacco crop for viable IPM/IDM strategies. In the last phase of training, the visit to Agricultural Museum and different field experiments was organized. The participants also practically prepared *Bourdex* Mixture.



TRAINING PROGRAMME ON AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS FROM INDIA: PROSPECTS AND PROCEDURE FOR STUDENTS

As a part of celebration of *Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav*@75 years of Independence and Celebration of Platinum Jubilee Year of B. A. College of Agriculture, a one day training programme for 7th semester B.Sc. (Hons.) Agri. students,



was organized on the topic, "Agricultural Exports from India: Prospects and Procedure" by Department of Agricultural Economics and WTO Cell, B. A. College of Agriculture, Anand Agricultural University, Anand on 5th September 2021.

The globalization of the world's economies is a driving factor for local industry and the primary sector to its next transformation. In order to become more competitive, there is a need to improve the efficiency, productivity, quality, technological enhancement of agricultural products. To know more about this globalization and export, this training programme was organized.

Five lectures were organized *viz*. a talk on status and growth of agricultural export from India and how to export: procedure & formalities, export of organic products and role of APEDA in promoting agri-exports, emerging trends in marketing and trade of agricultural commodities and exporter from Vadodara shared his personal and practical experiences on export of agricultural commodities.

LECTURE SERIES ON PARADIGM SHIFT IN 4th & 5th GENERATION AGRICULTURE

College of Agricultural Engineering and Technology, Godhra & Centre for Agricultural Market Intelligence (NAHEP-



CAAST), AAU, Anand jointly organized online lecture series on "Paradigm shift in 4th & 5th Generation Agriculture" on 15 September 2021 on the occasion of National

Engineers' Day. About 437 participants registered for this event. Two expert lectures were organized on different aspects of renewable or green energy initiatives with cost effective approaches, challenges, opportunities for the development of rural India. Morever, the technological interventions required and the growth of technology in Agricultural applications were discussed. Guest speakers with their rich experience and knowledge presented complex data and technologies to adopt with an ease for the participants to understand. Emerging trends, challenges to be addressed in integrating the technologies, research scopes, cost effective approaches and many challenges that are yet to be addressed were focused in their talks.

CERTIFICATE COURSE ON INSECTICIDES MANAGEMENT FOR INSECTICIDES DEALERS/ DISTRIBUTORS

Insecticide is one of the important agri-inputs in agriculture. The Insecticides is mostly marketed by dealers, distributors and retailers. Most of the farmers are dependent on insecticides dealers/ retailers for information related to insecticides and pest management. However, majority of the insecticides dealers do not have formal education in agriculture. It is essential therefore to impart technical knowledge on pesticides, pest management and advisory based on scientific recommendations.

In this context, Institute of Distance Education Anand (IDEA), Anand Agricultural University, Anand successfully completed two batches of 12 Day "Certificate Course on Insecticide Management for Insecticides dealers/ distributors" to equip them to acquire professional competency on pesticides & pest management and advisory services at SSK, AAU, Anand from June 2021 to September 2021 as per the guidelines given by the National Institute of Plant Health Management (NIPHM), Hyderabad. During the courses, total 76 Insecticide dealers/ distributors from various talukas of Ahmedabad district participated and lectures on various topics as well as practical sessions were conducted to acquire self experience through distinguished faculty of Anand Agricultural University, Anand. Training mannuals and practical kit were also distributed among to the trainees.



 Krushi Vigyan Kendra, AAU, Devataj organized 12-Day Certificate Course on Insecticides Management for Insecticides Dealers/ Distributors at Aniket Farmers' Hostel, AAU, Anand. During inaugural programme, welcome speech was given by Dr. A.C. Vaidya, Senior Scientist & Head, KVK Anand. Dr. H.B. Patel, Director of Extension Education, AAU, Anand emphasized that there

should be proper guidance to input dealers for optimum use of Insecticides. He also stated that such type of training will improve the



economic status of the farmers. Total 80 Insecticides dealers/distributors participated in this training programme. Total 20 lectures and 10 practicals were organized during this training programme on various topics viz study on management of weeds, insects and diseases of crops, Pesticide classification based on mode of action, entry, types of formulation and usage recommendations, symptoms of pesticides poisoning, first aid and their specific antidotes, responsibilities of dealers/ distributors and manufacturers, etc. Technical information and lectures were delivered by distinguished faculties of Anand Agricultural University, Anand and staff of KVK, Anand. This resource information was also given in the form of manuals and kits.

KVK, AAU, DEVATAJ CELEBRATED ICAR FOUNDATION DAY

KVK, AAU, Devataj celebrated ICAR Foundation Day on 18th July 2021 through online mode (Google Meet) on the theme 'Rainwater Harvesting. Dr. A. C. Vaidya, Senior Scientist and Head, KVK, AAU, Devataj discussed about the activities and role of ICAR in development of the agriculture and allied sector. Shri Arvindbhai Kunapara, Assistant Professor, Land and Water Conservation Department from Agricultural Engineering and Technology College, AAU, Godhra discussed about rainwater harvesting. He further provided guidance on the methods of collecting runoff water as well as the methods of collecting and storing water in the field.

Vaidya insisted all participants to develop entrepreneurship in value addition of fish.

Zala, (Assistant Research Scientist, ARS, AAU, Sansoli), respectively. After completion of training, kitchen garden kit distribution and plantation programme were organized.

Three farmers' training programmes on crop management practices during *Kharif* season were organized on 11th August 2021, 13rd August 2021 and 16th August 2021. Total 160 farmers remained present. Dr. M. B. Zala delivered lecture on crop protection measures in various crops. Dr. B. N. Thakker (Assistant Extension Educationist, ARS, AAU, Sansoli) delivered lecture on soil sample collection, analysis and benefits of soil testing report and economic farm management tactics.

STUDENT CORNER CELEBRATION OF TEACHERS' DAY


