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### *From the Desk of Vice Chancellor.....*

Science influences human development is an undeniable fact. To highlight the importance of science, the 'National Science Day' is celebrated across India on 28<sup>th</sup> February every year. It is celebrated to honour the contributions of scientists towards the development of the country. It also commemorates the discovery of the Scattering of light popularity known as **Raman Effect** by the prominent physicist **Sir Chandrasekhara Venkata Raman** who was awarded

the Nobel Prize in physics for this discovery in 1930. 'Raman Effect' refers to the phenomenon in spectroscopy which he discovered while working in the laboratory of the Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science, Kolkata. This was the first Nobel Prize for India in the field of physics and it was a remarkable discovery that paved the way for several future scientific advances. The National Council for Science & Technology asked the government of India in 1986 to designate February 28 as the National Science Day. Since 1987, the National Science Day pays tribute to the iconic physicist and calls on the Indian youth to follow in his footsteps. This year 2022, the NSD is being celebrated with the theme of "Integrated Approach in Science & Technology for Sustainable Future".

The theme of the National Science Day for 2022 emphasizes the adoption of an integrated approach in science and technology for sustainable future, which is the need of the era. There can be various approaches to achieve the sustainable future by incorporating the integrative outlook in four ways. One of them can be achieved by integration of all the scientific communities working on theme based approach. Second may be the integration of various disciplines of science including medical sciences for constructive output for the society. Third may be identifying the need of the other disciplines and incorporating multidisciplinary approach and the fourth would be integrating all approaches and making it a practical solution for the sustainable future by encouraging industrial and individual contributions by start-ups. The New Education Policy (NEP) also encourages a comprehensive, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary approach for reshaping the abilities of the youth of the country.

Being a Vice Chancellor of an agricultural university, I believe that the inclusive attitude in the field of Agriculture would definitely suffice the essential sustainable development through 'Science and Technology' and will positively benefit farmers and the society by and large. I am firm that with the collaborative efforts of scientific community we will accomplish the mission of achieving 'Sustainable Future'.

# 18<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL CONVOCATION OF AAU

The 18<sup>th</sup> convocation of Anand Agricultural University (AAU), Anand was successfully held on 2<sup>nd</sup> February, 2022 in active hybrid-mode. Shri Acharya Devvrat, the Hon. Chancellor of the University and Hon. Governor, Gujarat graced the occasion with his full-time online presence. Keeping in view the Covid-19 situation, all precautionary measures were taken, allowing a limited number of participants in physical mode of this ceremony. Which included all the awards winning scholars, faculty Deans, University officers, Heads of Departments, along with Hon. Vice Chancellors of various universities, AAU Board Members, Members of Academic Council and other invited guests. All other students, parents, and AAU officials/staff joined this 18<sup>th</sup> convocation via live broadcasting on AAU website.

In his welcome address, Dr. K. B. Kathiria, Hon. Vice Chancellor, Anand Agricultural University, conveyed his greetings and best wishes to all the successful scholars for their awards as well as degrees. He profusely welcomed Hon. Governor Shri of Gujarat, addressing him a factual and proficient visionary for Indian farming and as a big source of inspiration. After sharing glorious history, he meticulously

mentioned the legacy driven growth of AAU via hectic progressions delivered by its colleges, off-campus and technology transfer stations. He congratulated the faculty, students, and staff of AAU for securing 20<sup>th</sup> rank at national level.

During the convocation, 549 students were conferred with their UG, PG and Doctoral degrees cutting across 6 faculties of the universities. Out of these, 39 students obtained their PhD degree while 179 achieved their master's degree. The academic achievements of students, teachers,

Dr. Gautam Patel, Registrar, Anand Agricultural University, formally announced the names of award winners across the faculty as well as the passed-out scholar; who were sequentially awarded with medals on the stage. In all, 27 bright students were bestowed with 58 medals comprising 19 gold medals, 33 gold plated silver medals and 6 cash prizes across various faculties. AAU faculty members namely Dr. R. G. Parmar, Dr. K. V. Patel and Dr. H. P. Patel received the 'Best Teacher Award', 'Best Main Researcher Award' and 'Best Co-Researcher Award', respectively. Further 'Best Extension Award' for the year 2020 & 2021 were conferred to Dr. J. K. Patel and Dr. B. D. Patel, respectively.

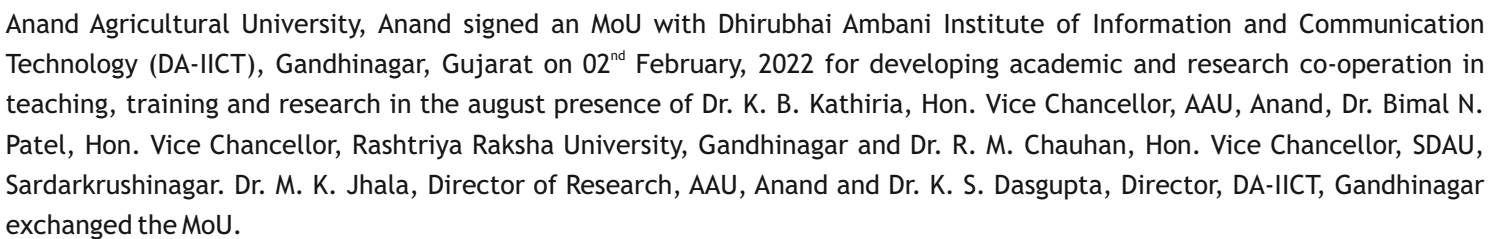
Dr. Bimal Patel, Hon. Vice Chancellor, Rashtriya Raksha University, Gandhinagar graced the occasion as the chief guest of the function. He started his speech by sharing his memories and connection with B. A. College of Agriculture way back in 80's when he used to be a student of this prestigious college. He emphasized, that futuristic scholars inevitably need to be better acquainted with smart digital technologies such as Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, GIS, Remote Sensing, IT, ICT, IoT, etc. keeping preserved the natural fundamental of agricultural knowledge.

In his convocation speech, Shri Acharya Devvrat, Hon. Governor of Gujarat, felt content with the overall progress and quality deliverables made by AAU in preceding year. Dr. Gautam Patel, the Registrar, Anand Agricultural University presented the formal thanks giving address. With conductance of national anthem, the 18<sup>th</sup> convocation programme was declared over.

# ORGANIZATION OF TRAINING PROGRAMMES

## TRAININGS ON ORGANIC FARMING

Department of Agronomy, B. A. College of Agriculture, AAU, Anand organized two five-days training programme for farmers on Organic two Farming from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> January, 2022 and 14<sup>th</sup> to 18<sup>th</sup> February, 2022, in which 32 and 33 farmers participated, respectively. These training programmes were conducted with the objective of imparting theoretical and practical training related to organic farming for the benefit of farmers. Issues such as management, crop protection, field management, weed management, cow based farming, certification system, market system etc. were discussed in depth and participants were acquainted with the organic farms and organic stores around Anand with the noble intention of inspiring participants to engage in organic farming were also carried out.

The feed back of the trained farmers was also taken at the end of the programmes, wherein all the farmers were fully satisfied with the knowledge gained and also committed to commence organic farming on his/her own farm. Dr. V. J. Patel, Professor and Head also highlighted the importance and opportunities of organic farming.

At the end of the training programme and vegetable seeds were distributed to the farmers.



## TRAINING ON INTEGRATED PEST MANAGEMENT

- Under the plan scheme “Integrated Pest Management” supported by the Government of Gujarat, three IPM trainings were conducted during January to March 2022 by the Department of Entomology, BACA, AAU, Anand. In these training programs, total 113 farmers participated from Dahod, Kheda and Anand district. During the training



programme, farmers were trained on the various aspects of IPM viz., cultural control, mechanical control, biological control, use of botanicals as well as chemical control measures. Farmers also visited different centers viz., Main Forage Research Station, Main Vegetable Research Station, Horticulture farm, Apiary and Agronomy farm at AAU, Anand.

- A four-day training program on “Integrated Pest Management in Agricultural Crops” was organized by KVK, AAU, Devataj in collaboration with Department of Entomology, BACA, AAU, Anand on 22<sup>nd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2022. Total of 40 farmers of Anand district remained present. Professor and Head of Department of Entomology, Dr. D. B. Sisodiya and Assistant Professor, Dr. H. C. Patel, were also remained present. During inaugural programme, Dr. A. C. Vaidya, Senior Scientist & Head, Krishi Vigyan Kendra urged the farmers to adopt non-chemical farming practices to reduce production cost as well as to increase crop quality and earning more income. Dr. D. B. Sisodiya provided information on the planning and various activities of the Department of Entomology. Dr. H. C. Patel gave detailed information regarding the academic, research and extension activities of the university. Dr. R. M. Patel, Scientist (Crop Protection), KVK, Devataj proposed vote of thanks.



## TRAINING ON FRESHWATER FISH FARMING



KVK, AAU, Devataj organized a five day training programme on Freshwater Fish Farming from 1<sup>st</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 at Aniket farmers' hostel, AAU, Anand.

Total 23 participants

from various districts of Gujarat state actively participated in this programme. Mr. J.H. Bhatt, Scientist (Fisheries) discussed about various technologies of freshwater aquaculture such as breeding and seed production of fishes,



fish seed rearing, feed management, soil and water management, disease management. Resource persons from fisheries departments were also invited for lectures. Practical aspects on feed formulation and preparation of farm made feed were also discussed. A field visit was organized at Government Fish Seed Production Center, Lingda Ta. Umreth. Certificates were distributed to all the participants during valedictory function.

### TRAINING ON BAKERY

A one day Bakery Training Program was organized by KVK, AAU, Devataj in collaboration with Bakery School, Polytechnic in Food Sciences and Home Economics, AAU, Anand on 19<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. This training was actively attended by 48 farm women. At outset Dr. A. C. Vaidya, Senior Scientist & Head, Krishi Vigyan Kendra welcomed the scientist and participants. Shri Hardikbhai A. Vaidya, Bakery Operator, Polytechnic in Food Science and Home Economics, AAU, Anand gave preliminary information on bakery recipes and various courses taught at Bakery school. He also practically demonstrated various bakery items such as *farali* biscuits, *Nankhatai*, chocolate, coconut biscuit etc. This

The programme ended with a vote of thanks by Shri Dhaval Savaliya, General Secretary of B. A. College of Agriculture.

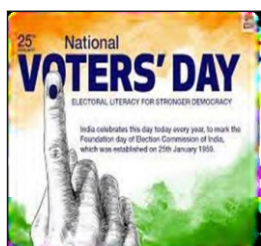
## NATIONAL VOTERS' DAY

### Internet and Network Management

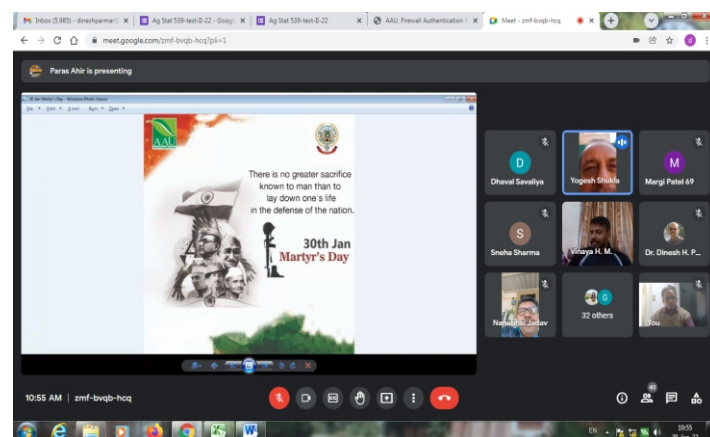
IT center provides and monitors the Internet facility through the LAN and Wi-Fi network at AAU campus and Vaso Campus including different colleges, departments, hostels.

### PUBLICATION OF FARM MAGAZINE

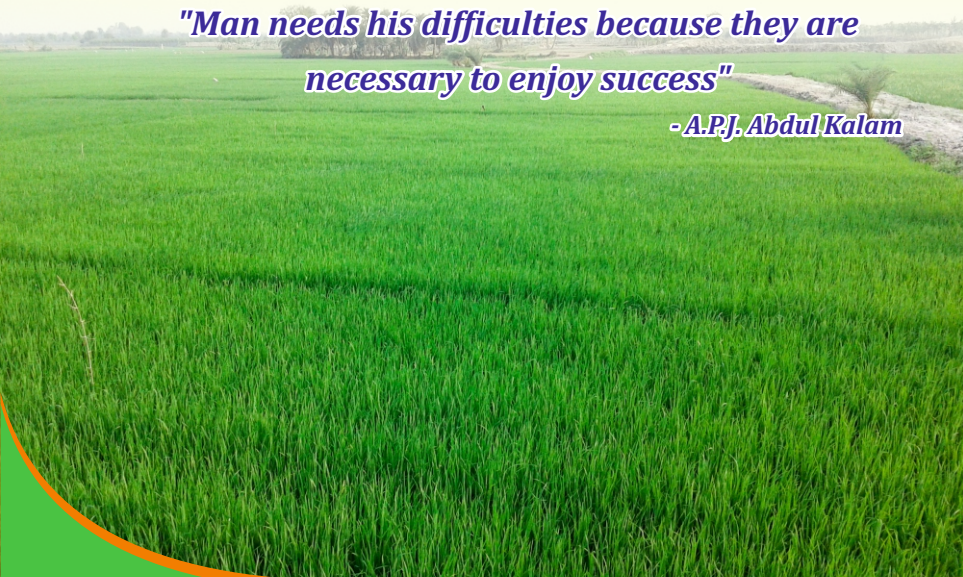
