Message

It is now well known that, *Krushi Mahotsav* has brought about a qualitative difference in the lives of farmers in Gujarat. During the year 2015, the *Krushi Mahotsav* was held from 22 April 2015 to 11 May 2015 on cluster basis in villages of Gujarat as per the district panchayat seats. As part of mega event, two days *Krushi Melas*, Agricultural Exhibition-cum-Sale and *Pashu Arogya Mela* were organized at



Lunavada, Dist. Mahisagar. The live demonstrations were exhibited by the agriculture, horticulture, dairy, food processing and agricultural engineering faculties of the University. Specifically, the star show of the *Krushi Mahotsav* 2015, the flagship agriculture initiative of Gujarat at Lunawada launch was the animal husbandry camp. In *Pashu Arogya Mela*, animals were diagnosed and treated for various diseases.

The successor of former Chief Minister, Shri Narendra Modi and First Woman Chief Minister Hon'ble Smt. Anandiben Patel described *Krushi Mahotsav* 2015 as a true *Yagna* for the agricultural development in Gujarat state.

Also, it is appreciated that lot of work has been done in water conservation, water-harnessing and canal networking. With 'Lab to Land approach', technical assistance is being offered to farmers with the help of scientist of Agricultural Universities. KRUSHI MAHOTSAV-2015 MEGA EVENT

At Lunavada, three main events (1) Inaugural function by Hon'ble Chief Minister (2) Agricultural exhibition-cum-sale and (3) *Pashu Arogya mela* were organized.

As a part of *Krushi Mahotsav*, a mega event was celebrated with combined efforts of the State Government, District Administration, Mahisagar and Anand Agricultural University, Anand during 30 April and 1 May 2015 at Lunavada, Mahisagar district.

An inaugural function of *Krushi Mahotsav* mega event 2015 for central Gujarat was organized at Taluka seed farm, Lunavada on 30 April 2015. Dr. N.C.Patel, Vice Chancellor shared the dais with Shri Babubhai Bokhiria, Hon'ble Cabinet Minister for Agriculture; Shri Bhupendrasinh Chudasma, Hon. Cabinet Minister for Education; Shri Pradipsinh Jadeja, Hon. Prabhari Mantri (Mahisagar District), Shri Jashabhai Barad, Hon. State Minister for Agriculture; Shri Jaydrathsingh Parmar, Hon. State Minister for Road and Building, Government of Gujarat and other Members of the Legislative assembly.

On the eve, various cultural programs were performed. Several ministers addressed the gathering. On arrival at Lunavada, First Mahila Chief Minister, Hon. Shrimati Anandiben Patel, after perfoming the holy 'Balram Pooja' and 'Gau Poojan' inaugurated the pashu arogya mela and visited various stalls and observed live surgical operations on animals by veterinarians. The Hon'ble Chief Minister appreciated the live operations and congratulated the scientists and veterinarians.

On 30 April, 2015 early in the morning at about 9.00 am, the farmers started to arrive and within an hour, the ground was fully brimming with about 18,000 farmers.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister then awarded the progressive farmers, distributed cheques to various beneficiaries and also released three books, one booklet, one telephonic diary and two DVDs on agricultural technologies published/made by AAU, Anand.

The MoU between AAU and Gujarat Agro Industries Corporation (GAIC) for NPK bioconsortia technology transfer was made in the presence of Smt. Anandiben Patel, Hon. Chief Minister of Gujarat State.

A set of agricultural literature was delivered to two *mahila sarpanchs* for establishing *krushi* library in their villages.

Krushi Mahotsav is a knowledge sharing rendezvous of the farming community of Gujarat. It is a month long event that brings together the farmers, scientists, Government officials and many more individuals concerned with agriculture. This Mahotsav is generally held for a month and begins on the auspicious planetary affluence of 'Akshay Tritiya (Akhatrij)', a day for worshiping Balramji, thou God of farmers. As a preparation part of the Krushi Mahotsav, training program was conducted for the participating scientists on 18 April 2015.

This event facilitates the seamless flow of knowledge from agricultural research labs to land. The Eleventh *Krushi Mahotsav* was celebrated by the state for 20 days from 22 April 2015 to 11 May 2015.

During this *Krushi Mahotsav*, total 253 seminars and exhibition cum sales were organized based on seats of District Panchayat in 64 talukas of central Gujarat. Two groups of scientists (185 numbers) were engaged to facilitate the process of knowledge sharing in the seminar. During the seminar, the team of expert scientists related to Agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry, Dairying, Food Processing, Agril. Engineering etc. explained the farmers the latest developments in various fields (agronomy, plant protection, farm implements, water conservation, irrigation methods, bio-fertilizers, bio-pesticides, bio control of insects/pests, cultivation practices, medicinal and aromatic plants,

horticulture, animal husbandry, surgical operation, clean milk production, cattle feed, mineral mixture, fisheries, green/net/poly house etc.) for adoption to earn more profit and for better livelihood. The Scientists also provided guidance and possible solutions on the spot for the problems and queries posed by the farmers/animal keepers. The agricultural exhibition cum sale was organized at the same place of seminar. Sales of seeds, liquid biofertilizer, mineral mixture, trichoderma culture at nominal rate were arranged for the farmers by AAU. Total 2667 packets worth ₹ 2,49,360/were sold to the farmers of central Gujarat. Besides this, literature in the form of folders and pamphlets on various subjects were also distributed to the farmers.



AAU BIO NPK (PGPB) CONSORTIUM LIQUID BIOFERTILIZER TECHNOLOGY TRANSFER MOU WITH GAIC

MoU for technology transfer of *Anubhav* Bio NPK Liquid biofertilizer between Anand Agricultural University and Gujarat Agro Industries Corporation Ltd., Gandhinagar has been signed on 30 April 2015 in esteemed presence of Hon'ble CM of Gujarat Mrs. Anandiben Patel on the occasion of *Krushi Mahotsav-2015*, to make this biofertilizer formulation easily available to the farmers.

The plant growth promoting bacterial consortium formulation has been developed under a project sponsored by DBT, GOI at BioFertilizers Dept, AAU, Anand and this innovative farming technology was honoured with Mahindra Krushi Siksha Samman Award-2013. The Indian patent of the technology has been published in Indian patent Journal No. 50/2014 dtd. 12/12/14.

AAU has first time developed such Bio-NPK liquid biofertilizer consortium, which contains mixture of five native efficient bacteria viz. Nitrogen fixers (Azotobacter, Azospirillum) as well as phosphate and potash solubilizers (three Bacillus spp.). Use of Anubhav Bio NPK consortium can save 25% N, P and K, three type of chemical fertilizers with 10% increase in yield. In Gujarat, about 145 lakh hectares of land is under cultivation and about 8 lakh hectares under drip irrigation. Farmers using such liquid biofertilizer consortium can reduce cost of cultivation as well as decrease pollution in soil, water and air.

The sale of aforementioned liquid Bio NPK consortium has been started by Dept. of Microbiology, AAU for farmers and during Krushi Mahotsav 2015 in agricultural exhibition cum sale programme organized at 242 district panchayat seats in Middle Gujarat, this biofertilizer was made available to farmers.

11TH COMBINED JOINT AGRESCO MEETING

The Eleventh Combined Joint Meeting of Agricultural Research Council (AGRESCO-2015) of SAUs of Gujarat was held at Anand Agricultural University, Anand during 07-09 April 2015. The Inaugural session of the meeting was graced by Shri Babubhai Bokhiriya, Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture, Government of Gujarat; Shri. Dilipbhai Patel, Hon'ble Member of Parliament: Shri Jasvantsinh Solanki. President, Anand District Panchayat; Shri Pragneshbhai Patel, President of Anand Nagarpalika; Dr. N. C. Patel, Vice Chancellor of AAU; Dr. A. R. Pathak, Vice Chancellor, JAU; Dr. C. J. Dangaria, Vice Chancellor, NAU; Dr. Ashok Patel, Vice Chancellor, SDAU; Prof. M. C. Varshneya, Vice Chancellor, Kamdhenu University; Dr. B. R. Shah, Director of Horticulture: Dr. A. J. KacchiaPatel, Director of Animal Husbandry and Dr. K. B. Kathiria, Director of Research & Dean P. G. Studies, AAU, Anand. Dr. K. B. Kathiria welcomed the dignitaries, invited guests, conveners of various subcommittee and scientists. He highlighted the research activities carried out by different AGRESCO sub-committees and various recommendations deliberated for farming as well as scientific community. Dr. N. C. Patel, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of AAU, Anand welcomed the dignitaries and explained the significance of this meeting. The Combined Joint AGRESCO meeting of SAUs of Gujarat was inaugurated by Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture Shri Babubhai Bokhiriya and other dignitaries. During the occasion, Shri Babubhai Bokhiriya launched the revamped AAU website as well as Mineral mixture developed by the scientists of Anand Agricultural University. Two informative publications in vernacular language viz; Aaushadhiy Vanaspatio: Olakh ane Upyog (Medicinal plants: identification and use) and Khedutopyogi Bhalamano 2004 to 2014 (Recommendations for farming community 2004 to 2014) were also released. Moreover, exchange of MoU between Anand Agricultural University and Vasundhara Agribiotech, Rajkot for transfer of technology of tissue culture date palm was also done in august presence of all the dignitaries. During the Technical session, conveners of various research sub-committees presented the proceedings of the respective sub-committee meets and the recommendations were deliberated and finalized.

ICAR, DAC INTERFACE MEETING KHARIF 2015 FOR GUJARAT

ICAR-Central Research Institute for Dryland Agriculture (CRIDA) Hyderabad along with Department of Agriculture and Co-operation (DAC), GOI, AAU, Anand, Gujarat and Department of Agriculture, GOG organized contingency preparedness interface meeting with various stakeholders on 29 May 2015 hosted by National Initiative on Climate Resilient Agriculture (NICRA) Dept. of Agril. Meteorology, BACA, AAU, Anand. Dr. D.M. Korat, ADR, AAU acted as Nodal Officer of the meeting.

This interface meeting was started with welcome speech of Dr. H. R. Patel PI of NICRA project. Shri Arun Kumar Solanki, IAS, Pr. Secretary, Agriculture and Cooperation, GOG; Dr. Ashish Kumar Bhutani, JS, DAC; Dr. N.C. Patel, Hon.VC, AAU; Dr. B.R. Shah, Director, Dept. of Agriculture; Dr. M. Maheswari, CRIDA, ICAR; Director of Research, Director of Extension of different SAUs of Gujarat, Representatives from Seed Corporation, Gujarat, Land Development Corporation, Divisional and District Heads of Agril. Dept., Director, ATMA, Zonal Project Director, Project Coordinators of KVKs, and CRIDA-Agricultural Contingency Cell (ACC) scientists participated in this meeting.

Dr. M. Maheswari informed about availability of contingency plans for about 580 districts across India and appraised the efforts being made to create awareness among various stakeholders at district level on the need for operationalization of contingency plans. She also appraised updating process of available district contingency plans and their inclusion in recent research developments.

Dr. Ashish Kumar Bhutani desired that the district level contingency plans be made available as advisories. He stressed that there is a need to cover large numbers of farmers, especially from small and marginal farmers, with crop/ weather insurance program.

Shri Arun Kumar Solanki suggested that SAUs may compile better natural resource management technologies at district level and be provided to Gujarat State Land Development Corporation. Every nodal agency such as seed corporation, land development corporation should have their own plans for each district to address the contingency scenarios those emerge from aberrant weather conditions. Awareness meetings to various stakeholders be organized by University, ATMA, KVKs, Divisional and District level agricultural department officers. There is a need to enhance the coverage of crop/ weather insurance programmes in a targeted manner specially for non-loan farmers like other developmental programmes. SAUs should prepare the content for recently launched Kisan Channel by Doordarshan.

BRAIN STORMING MEETING ON NILGAI/WILD BOAR MENACE CONTROL

Under the presidentialship of Dr. N. C. Patel, Hon. VC, AAU, a brain-storming meeting was organized at Veterinary College on 17 June 2015 for officers from the Forest dept., Animal husbandry dept., AAU, Progressive farmers, Sarpanchs and representatives from different NGOs. Dr. A. M. Thaker, Dean & Principal, Veterinary College, Anand in his welcome speech informed to develop various control

strategies in order to reduce free-ranging populations of nilgai and wild boars to avoide crop damage faced by marginal farmers.

Hon. VC, AAU, Dr. N. C. Patel in his inauguration speech emphasized on establishment of a collaborative action plan with active involvement of Forest Department officials, scientists from Veterinary College-Anand, Sarpanchs of different villages, farmers as well as other stake holders to control nilgai and wild boar populations.

Dr. P. K. Borad, AAU and Mr. Brahmbhatt, presented the over all aspects of various control measures adopted by farmers and subsidies and help provided by the forest department. The Chief Guest of the program Mr. Bharat Pathak, Director, GEER Foundation, Gandhinagar imparted information on Wildlife Protection Act of India as well as common methods used for control of nilgai invasion such as use of chain-links and growing cactus plants on the periphery of the farm. He discussed in detail regarding strategic planning needed to be represented to GOI for declaration of the wild boar and nilgai into least concerned category in areas with higher incidence of crop damage.

Dr. K. B. Kathiria, Director of Research, AAU concluded the session by appreciating the efforts of the Forest Department and suggested that the work which is being carried out by the department should reach to people in form of literatures for development of conservation awareness and he also assured positive support from the eminent scientists from AAU for the same.




