

Report of the 16th All India Inter Agricultural Universities Youth Festival 2016

16th All India Inter Agricultural Universities Youth Festival was organized by Orissa University of Agriculture and Technology (OUAT), Bhubaneswar, Orissa during 1-4 February, 2016.
