Introduction

Shri Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel who dared the Indian farmers to dream of being a part of the country's prosperity. For his uncompromising commitment to national integration, he earned the title of "Iron Man of India". His devotion and loyalty to his country, his duty to his fellow countrymen and all his fearlessness made him an iconic leader of our country. In agriculture, he supported the rights of peasants against both the former landlords and the state. In 1918, he led the 'No Tax Campaign' and urged the farmers not to pay taxes after the British imposed heavy taxes after the floods in Kaira. In 1928, the farmers of Bardoli again faced massive tax hikes and the government seized their lands in retaliation when farmers were unable to pay the heavy taxes. His efforts played a vital role and the lands were returned to farmers. Due to his devotion to work for the farmers' rights and successful peasants' movement he got the name "Sardar". In the memories of iron man Sardar Patel for his valuable services to the farming community, the Gujarat Agricultural University established 'Sardar Smruti Kendra' at Anand in 1975.

Motto

- 5. To help in improvement in the agro-economic status of rural people & guidance given about value addition of farm products


Under the complex of Sardar Smruti Kendra there are three wings: -
