3) Ganesh Mahotsav

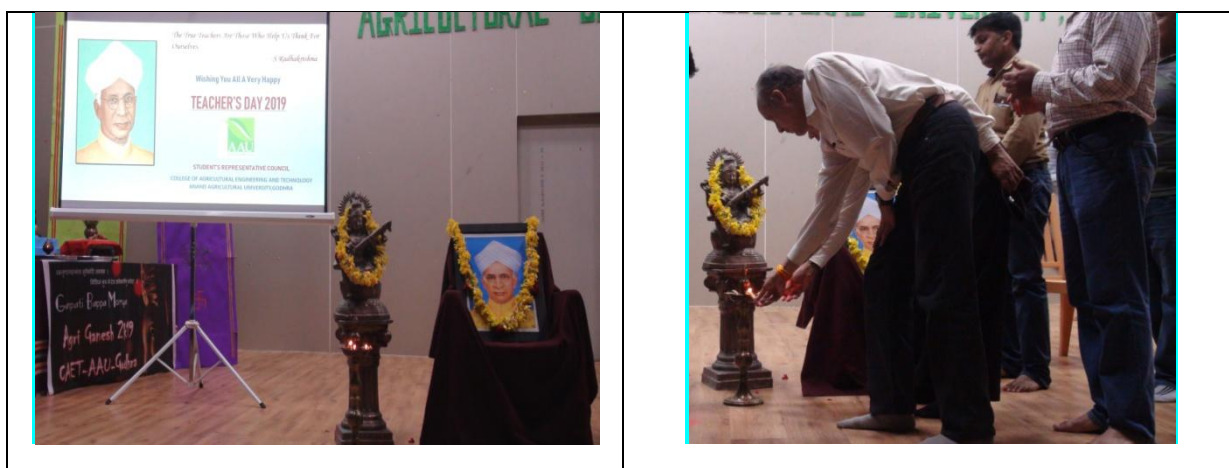
