

Dr. Subrota Hati receives NAAS Young Scientist Award

Dr. Subrota Hati, Assistant Professor, Dairy Microbiology Department, SMC College of Dairy Science, Anand has been conferred the most coveted NAAS Young Scientist Award: 2017-18 in Animal Sciences sponsored by National Academy of Agricultural Sciences (NAAS), New Delhi. The award



was given by Shri Shri Radha Mohan Singh, Central Agricultural Minister, Govt. of India during XIV Agricultural Science Congress held in NASC Complex, New Delhi on 20th February, 2019 in the presence of DG ICAR and other dignitaries.

We are proud to state that in the category of Animal Sciences, Dr Subrota Hati is the first person receiving this award from Dairy Science background (B.Tech. in Dairy Technology). The award carries a Gold Medal, Cash prize of Rs 75,000/- and a Citation.



The award was given on the basis of his published research papers (NAAS rating more than 6.0) with citation, book chapters, and several other awards at National and International level. Dr Subrota is also recipients of fellowships from National Academies for his outstanding contribution on Animal Sciences, particularly, in Dairy Microbiology. His work on purification and characterization of antihypertensive peptides derived from different species of fermented milks (cow, buffalo, camel, goat and soy milks) produced by indigenous well characterized lactic acid bacteria helps to manage the hypertension without having any side effects.
