Dr. H. Shivanna, Hon. Vice Chancellor, University of Agricultural Sciences, Bengaluru visited Anand Agricultural University, Anand during 20th to 23rd December 2017. He had an interaction meeting with the Hon. Vice Chancellor, Dr. N.C. Patel, Director of Research and Dean Post Graduate Studies, Dr. K.B. Kathiria, the University Officers of AAU, all the Deans, Unit Heads and HoDs, which was followed by discussion on various areas of mutual interest between UAS Bengaluru and AAU, Anand. The Interaction meeting started with the introduction of Dr. H. Shivanna by Dr. M.K. Jhala, Associate Director of Research, AAU. Dr. N.C. Patel, Hon. Vice Chancellor, AAU in his opening remarks welcomed Dr. H. Shivanna and asked the University officers to explore the possibilities of collaborative research work, between the two universities. Dr. R.S. Pundir, Prof. & Head, Dept. of Agribusiness Economics and Policies, IABMI, AAU, Anand made a brief presentation about various educational, research and extension activities of AAU and highlighted significant achievements made by the University.

As for the specific collaborative activities between AAU and UAS, Dr. Shivanna showed deep interest in various areas of mutual interest including plant breeding, an area of strong collaborative interest as suggested by Dr. K.B Kathria, DR & Dean PG Studies, AAU, Anand. Dr. Shivanna, asked the Hon. Vice Chancellor, AAU, to send a team of senior officers of AAU to visit UAS, Bengaluru to explore more closely the areas of collaborative activities between the two universities.

Dr. H. Shivanna then visited Sardar Patel Educational Museum, Biofertilizer unit, Tissue Culture Laboratory, Pesticide Residue Laboratory, College of FPT & BE and Vidya Dairy, AAU, Anand. He also visited AMUL dairy. He was impressed by

the educational system and allied activities being carried out at AAU, Anand as well as by the available state of art infrastructural facilities.
