Poultry Research Station, Veterinary & Dairy Science Unit of (A.A.U.), Anand is actively engaged in poultry research, teaching and extension-education activities. Various native (indigenous) and exotic breeds of poultry are being genetically improved and conserved at Poultry Research Station. In the year 2012-13, fertile eggs of native poultry breed of Gujarat i.e. "Ankaleshwar", having importance in rural poultry farming were procured under the guidance of Dr. K. B. Kathiria, former Director of Research & Dean P. G. Studies and present Vice Chancellor, A.A.U., Anand. These fertile eggs were artificially incubated and chicks were generated at Poultry Research Station. From this base population, a genetically improved breeder stock was established and is conserved under plan scheme of A.A.U. and also under ICAR sponsored All India Co-ordinated Research Project. Approximately 60,000 chicks of this breed are being supplied yearly to needy rural poultry farmers. Applications for "Breed Conservation Award" are being invited by ICAR-National Bureau of Animal Genetic Resources (ICAR-NBAGR), Karnal, every year, since the year 2017, from livestock keepers and institutions from all over the country to promote and encourage them, who are engaged in indigenous breed conservation. Studies, A.A.U., Anand, Poultry Research Station, A.A.U., Anand had applied for "Breed Conservation Award-2022" (Institution Award).
