Gujarat domicile and pass out students of SAUs of Gujarat State/ICAR accredited SAUs of other states shall be eligible for admission, further, if seat remains vacant, non-domicile of Gujarat State but pass-out students of SAUs of Gujarat shall be considered for admission. However, candidate pass out from private Universities/Colleges not approved by State Government and not accredited by ICAR will not be eligible.

The duly filled form along with the Demand Draft of ₹ 1000/- (One thousand only) in favour of "AAU Fund A/c" should be reach to The Registrar, Anand Agricultural University, Anand Campus, Anand-388 110, Gujarat on or before 08/08/2019.

After scrutiny, the list of eligible candidates will be displayed on AAU website (www.aau.in) and website of Gujarat State Agricultural Universities Common Admission (www.gsauca.in) and the eligible candidates will be called for the entrance test, group discussion and personal interview. The final merit list of the candidates for admission shall be prepared by giving the weightage to the score in Entrance test, Group Discussion and Personal Interview as (50:25:25) respectively.

Those candidates, who will finally secure the admission in MBA(ABM) Programme, will have to pay the full fees for the first semester immediately. Failing the same may lead to disqualification from the admission. The fee must be paid either in cash or electronically using Debit Card or Credit Card.

All candidates have to download the admission form from the Anand Agricultural University's website (www.aau.in) or website of Gujarat State Agricultural Universities Common Admission (www.gsauca.in). After scrutiny, the list of eligible candidates will be displayed on AAU website (www.aau.in) and website of Gujarat State Agricultural Universities Common Admission (www.gsauca.in) and the eligible candidates will be called for the entrance test. The final merit list of the candidates for admission shall be prepared by giving the weightage to the score in Entrance test and post-graduation degree (50:50) respectively.

Those candidates, who will finally secure the admission in Ph.D. (Agribusiness Management) Programme, will have to pay the full fees for the first semester immediately. Failing the same may lead to disqualification from the admission. The fee must be paid either in cash or electronically using Debit Card or Credit Card.

## <u>General Instruction to Candidates for Post Graduate Studies A candidate is expected to read and study the prospectus and the application form carefully:</u>

- 1. All entries in the application form must be made legible by the candidate himself. Incomplete application will not be considered.
- **2.** Attested Photostat copies of the below mentioned documents should be attached with the application form.
  - (i) School Leaving Certificate / Birth Certificate
  - (ii) SSCE and HSCE/Polytechnic mark sheet and certificate
  - (iii) Mark sheets of all the semesters / years
  - (iv) Transcript
  - (v) Provisional Passing Certificate/ Provisional Degree Certificate
  - (vi) Degree Certificate
  - (vii) Caste Certificate in case of SC / ST and SEBC or certificate of EWS candidate of Gujarat State from competent authority of the Gujarat State. The candidates belonging to SEBC should produce the "Non creamy layer certificate" in the prescribed format issued by the competent authority of the Gujarat State with validity as per the resolution No.SSP/122015/455246/A dt.26/04/2016 and prescribed certificate of EWS as per resolution no. EWS/122019/45903/A dated 25/1/2019 issued by Department of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of Gujrat, Gandhinagar, falling which, the candidate will not be considered against reserved seats for SEBC/EWS category.
  - (viii) Medical Fitness Certificate.
  - (ix) Physically Handicap Certificate if applicable.
  - (x) Character Certificate from where candidate obtained last degree.
- **3.** Original Certificate / Mark sheet / Documents should not be sent. However Original Certificate / Mark Sheet / Documents will have to be produced at the time of admission / counseling and payment of fees.
- **4.** Student from any other University shall be disqualified for admission to the Post-graduate study, if Migration Certificate is not submitted within one month after admission.
- **5.** Student coming from other University will have to obtain the Eligibility Certificate from the Anand Agricultural University on payment of prescribed fees, within one month after admission.
- **6.** A candidate admitted to the Post-Graduate programme will have to apply separately for Hostel Admission at the time of joining the college.
- **7.** Fees once paid will not be refunded.
- **8.** Candidates who are successful in securing admission will be duly intimated about their selection. No separate intimation will be given to the unsuccessful candidates.
- **9.** Once admitted, request for change of subject / college / university will not be entertained in any circumstances including mutual transfer.
- **10.** The candidate must bring photo identity proof (Identity card, Driving license, Aadhar card, EPIC card, PAN card etc.) for identity verification at the time of entrance test failing which he/she will not be allowed to appear in Entrance Test examination or Group Discussion or Counseling.
