

Kisan Gosthi organized at ARS Sansoli

To upgrade the knowledge of farmers towards modernized farming, animal husbandry and to solve out their farming related problems, a KISAN GOSTHI was organized at Farm Technology Training Centre-Nenpur with collaboration of Agricultural Technology Management Agency- Kheda (ATMA) on 10th September, 2018. Total 100 farmers of Mahemdavad taluka had enthusiastically participated in the programme. Dr. B. N. Patel (Unit Head, ARS, Sansoli), Dr. Mahesh Parikh (Ex. Assistant Director, Animal Husbandry), Prof. S. A. Sipai (Assistant Extension Educationist, ARS, Sansoli), Sh. Mitesh Patel (Employee, Paragon Drip Irrigation Ltd.), Dr. T. R. Patel (Research Associate, ARS, Sansoli) and Sh. Dahyabhai Dabhi (Progressive Farmer, Kathalal) elaborated their views on need of modernized farming, sustainable agriculture, organic farming, ideal animal husbandry, clean milk production, micro irrigation system etc. They advised farmers to change their perception towards prevailing modernization in agricultural sectors and to approach this concept for the betterment of livelihood. Lack of unity, co-operation, coordination and negative attitude of farmers towards farming among the small and marginal farmers were major lacunas of farming community as also suggested by them. They had also interacted with farmers for their dissonance regarding daily farming practices and suggested proper remedies. At last they appealed farmers to make their deliberate communication with agricultural institutes and simultaneously adopt the recent advances made in agriculture thereby increase farm income and social status.
