



Training Programmes at ARS Sansoli

Two training programmes on “**Cropping Practices of Kharif Crops**” and “**Doubling the farmers’ income through Agriculture and Animal Husbandry**” were organized at Farm Technology Training Centre-Nenpur on 26/06/2018 and 28/06/2018. Total 63 farmers from different villages of Mahemdavad taluka were enthusiastically participated in the said programmes.

Dr. B. N. Patel (Unit Head, ARS, Sansoli) had elaborated the brief outline on research and extension activities carried out by the centre. Lecture on “Package of Practices of Important Kharif Crops” was delivered by Dr. J. K. Patel (Associate Research Scientist, ARS, Sansoli).

Dr. Mahesh Parikh (Ex. Assistant Director of Animal Husbandry, Mahemdavad) had delivered his talk on “Animal Husbandry: A Way Ahead to Doubling the Farmers’ Income”. Lecture on “Demand Driven Approaches of Agriculture to Doubling the Farmers’ Income” was given by Prof. S. A. Sipai (Assistant Extension Educationist, ARS, Sansoli). Talk on “Drip Irrigation: An Economic Way for Behoof of the Farmers” had been given by Dr. T. R. Patel (Research Associate, ARS, Sansoli). A short video film on “Cropping Practices of Paddy” was also shown to participants for their patronage. At last all farmers took an oath “**My Conscience as a Citizen of India to Make It Clean**” as part of *Swachha Bharat Abhiyan*. For practical exposure to the farmers, a field visit of centre was also carried out.
