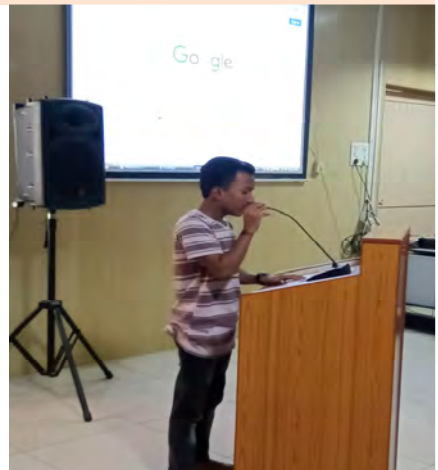
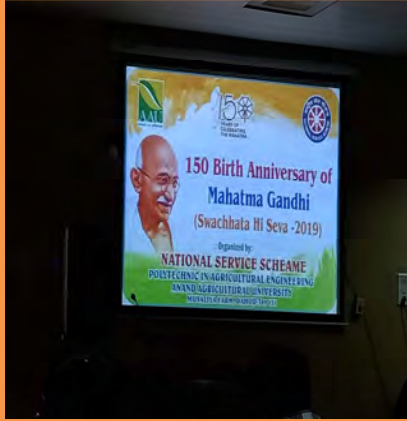


150th Birth Anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi
