About the Course :

Market Intelligence is the process of collecting relevant information related to the existing market prices, domestic and global agricultural supply and demand conditions, policy environment and other relevant factors; converting those into usable form through scientific modeling and stakeholders' perceptions; and disseminating through effective means so that informed and effective decisions can be taken by the farmers and other stakeholders.

The main purpose of Agricultural Market Intelligence is to disseminate accurate and timely marketing information so as to support in marketing decision making and marketing efforts of entrepreneurs, farmers, government, development organizations, academicians, and researchers. The course includes different concept and analytics of Market Intelligence in the broad area of agriculture and its allied sectors. The course includes the analysis of market integration, price forecast and its validation, demand & supply, total factor productivity as well as global intelligence and commodity futures trading. The participants will learn different aspects of agricultural market intelligence and its applications.
