Modification of existing admission criteria for MBA (ABM) and Ph.D. (ABM) Programme

Notification

It is hereby notified to all concerned that vide Item No.54.17 of the 54th meeting of the Academic Council held on 27/08/2020, the Academic Council of the Anand Agricultural University has resolved as under.

“It is resolved that considering the common admission for SAUs in ABM faculty, the Academic Council approves the following modifications.

- (i) From the academic year 2020-2021, common MBA (ABM) and Ph.D. (ABM) admission will be conducted for Gujarat State Agricultural Universities.
- (ii) For academic year 2020-2021, MBA (ABM) admission will be entirely based on entrance test and for subsequent years (2021-2022 onwards), Group discussion requirement as one of the criteria for admission will be reviewed by Deans of Agribusiness Management institute of Gujarat State Agricultural Universities and action will be implemented accordingly for subsequent years.
- (iii) For the admission in Ph.D. (ABM) Programme, weightage will be given on 50: 50 basis for PG degree score and entrance test marks.
- (iv) The cut-off marks of Entrance test for MBA & Ph.D. admission shall be as decided by the Common Admission Committee of SAUs.
