UNLEASH started in Denmark in 2017 and moved to Singapore in 2018 and Shenzhen, China, in 2019. During COVID-19, UNLEASH launched a series of digital activities to continue to build capacity among global youth and launch SDG-solutions amidst the pandemic.



It was placed at Infosys' Mysuru Development Center, one of the world's largest corporate universities. UNLEASH has been recognized as one of the world's most influential sustainability brands, having engaged 5,000 young people from 167 countries and facilitated the development of 700 SDG solutions with +300 partners.



Mr. Vishal Agravat developed an electric harvester as his PhD project under Dr. R. Swarnkar, Professor, Dept. of FMPE and on basis of it the selection was possible as global talent into this prestigious innovation lab. In Lab the talents were divided into the team of five on the basis of their interests, domicile country and cultural aspects. Given freedom to choose any problem of their interest. He had given his inputs in SDG 7. The solution of his team for the women of the Sub Saharan African counties who still cooks using traditional stoves that is harmful to their health and consumes much time for the cooking process. A process was suggested for those women which includes the pellet based stoves

and community approach to mitigate this issue as well as it promotes earnings to the women.
