(i) For Boys Cadet:

It is a voluntary organization helping India in nation-building. The camps organized play a vital role in national integration through interaction among different caste, creed and culture. With a view to giving a boost to the youth in the positive direction, NCC has been included in the course curriculum. The NCC unit of BACA is attached with 4 Gujarat Battalion, NCC, Vallabh Vidyanagar. The unit consists of two platoons of 100 cadets.

58 NCC cadets of B.A.College of Agriculture were attended Combined Annual Training Camp (CATC-I) at Thamna organized by 4 Guj Bn NCC Vallabh Vidyanagar from 05.09.21 to 11.09.21. There were total 5 Associate NCC officers from V.V.Nagar Group. This camp is Annual Training Camp. During CATC Thamna cadets got first prize in various competitions like volleyball, Tug of war and camp senior. Due to Covid-19 pandemic another camp schedules are not done.

(ii) For Girls Cadets

NCC Girl unit working under B A College of Agriculture enrolls girl cadets from BACA, Horticulture College, AIT and FPT colleges of Anand Agricultural University. IN the year 2021-22 total 21 vacancy was provided to enroll the first year cadets and all the vacancies are filled. Total girl cadets are enrolled for three years.

This year girl cadets have shown incredible interest by participating in various social and adventurous activities carried out by 4 Guj Girls BN, Vidyanagar Group and B A College of Agriculture throughout the year.
