## "Plastic Free Campus Movement"

India is set to impose a nation-wide ban on single-use plastic (including plastic bags, straws, cups, plates, small bottles and certain types of sachets) on October 2, 2019, on the occasion of the 150<sup>th</sup> birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi. India generates about 9.4 million tonnes of plastic waste each year and with no effective disposal method, the plastic waste ends up the roadsides, in landfills and water bodies.

To make CAET campus plastic free, a special plastic free cleanliness drive was carried out on occasion of Gandhi Jayanti (02/10/2019). NSS volunteers of first year and second year of CAET were actively participated in the cleanliness drive. They visited various places in campus and make them plastic waste free by collecting plastics garbage and other plastic
