**INTRODUCTION**

Indiscriminate use of chemical fertilizers, insecticides-pesticides, herbicides etc resulted into a rise in cost of production, and also deteriorates quality of natural resources viz; soil, water and environment along with quality of crop and animal produces, which ultimately adversely influence human life. In agriculture, the market-led innovations have frequently generated processes and products that affect the environment and put sustainable development at risk. Sustainable “Yogic” agriculture integrates thought-based meditative practices, it is a method that reduces costs while helping to create happy and resilient rural communities. This method of farming includes understanding the self as a spiritual being, igniting the dormant positive inner energy of self and channelizing the energy of the mind through meditation to empower all the five elements. Farmers use bio-diverse system-wide approach. Sustainable “Yogic” farming recognizes all the elements of farming; animals, birds, flying and crawling insects, micro-organisms, domestic seeds, vegetation, surrounding ecosystems and the natural elements.
