Student of SMC College of Dairy Science, Anand bagged Rs. 1,70,000/- prize money in Biothon competition sponsored by GSBTM, Govt. of Gujarat

Gujarat State Biotechnology Mission (GSBTM), Govt. of Gujarat had organized a State level competition called "Biothon: Hackathon of Biotech Solutions for State Problem-2018". This was organized for motivating the scientific thinkers and innovators to come up with biotechnologybased solutions for state/ community problems in a defined time-limit. using β -galactosidase from Lactobacilli was developed. Ms. Shrushti has been awarded Rs. 1,00,000/- for being the winner and her institution, i.e Anand Agricultural University has been paid Rs. 20,000/- as a token money for the selected project.
