Thalassemia Screening Test and Counselling Vaso campus, AAU, Vaso – 387 380

Thalassemia is a blood disorder passed down through families (inherited) in which the body makes an abnormal form or inadequate amount of hemoglobin. The disorder results in large numbers of red blood cells being destroyed, which leads to anemia. In context to this the *Thalassemia Screening Test and Counselling* was undertaken at College of Agriculture & Polytechnic in Agriculture, AAU, Vaso under NSS Programme with the help of Indian Redcross Society, Gujarat State Branch, Ahmedabad on 16th November 2019.
