### The following matters were discussed in the meeting:

- A comprehensive review of the SSR preparation was conducted. Departments were reminded to finalize pending sections as early as possible.
- The increasing use of stationery has been observed across various departments, leading to significant costs. The importance of sustainability and reducing waste was emphasized, along with the promotion of paperless practices.
- A brief discussion was held on Organization of a Suvarnaprashan Camp for Children Aged 0 to 15 Years with an emphasis on promoting traditional health practices. The Director of Student's Welfare briefed the committee on the upcoming event.
- The meeting discussed the adoption of environmentally sustainable practices under the Green Campus Initiative. Emphasis was placed on reducing energy consumption, increasing green cover, promoting waste segregation, and enhancing water conservation efforts within the university. Proposals included the installation of solar panels, rainwater harvesting systems, and the introduction of eco-friendly measures in daily operations.
- As the Diwali holidays approach, measures to ensure the security of the university campus were discussed. The Registrar's Office raised concerns regarding the vulnerability of departments left unmonitored during the extended break.
