





The camp began with the interaction with community members for rapport building and to develop understanding about welfare of the village. For the Special Camp, Dr. K V Vala, Programme Officer, NSS cell visited the village before commencing of the camp and met Sarpanch of the village, ward members and other influential members of the community. The plan of organizing the special camp was discussed at the village. The plan and its utility were appreciated by the Sarpanch and other members of the village and they agreed for the camp to be organized. After the confirmation, a meeting with NSS volunteers was arranged on 3rd March, 2022. In this meeting a brief presentation was made to the volunteers and plan for the camp was discussed. The volunteers excitingly participated in the discussion and planned the road map for camp along with guided supervision of NSS Program Officer.

Major activities undertaken during special camp 2022

Day 1: Meeting with villagers and door to door survey in village and cleanliness

The day 1 of NSS Camp comprised of bunch of programmes like NSS song, NSS clap, Fit India (Yoga), village survey and cleanliness arranged. The volunteers were guided by campus ambassador Arjunsinh Parmar and Bhakti Mangalpara. Seven groups were created which comprised of seven volunteers and one of the volunteer from each group was assigned as a leader to monitor the activities of the group and co-ordinate with other members of the group. The day 1 commenced with NSS Song and followed by NSS clap. After that, the volunteers proceeded towards Patel Community Hall, where they performed yoga under the fit India mission.

The volunteers then proceeded towards conducting a survey in the village of Gana. The volunteers were divided in the seven groups of seven members each. The volunteers' whole heartedly interacted with the people residing there and also give solution to their problems. Through the entire survey we were supposed to know as well as acknowledge them about the organic farming, milling operation, dairy technology, etc. Survey was all about addressing various problems faced by farmers or common people. Survey last for about two hours. After the lunch we assembled for the good conversation regarding the learning we all got from the survey and all this learning we had to convey to our fellow group members under Programe Officer (NSS) Dr. K. V. Vala, this took about 3 hours. The day ended with the cleanliness programme. The volunteers took up broom sticks and cleaned the streets and Patel Community Hall. As the end was approaching, there was a sense of satisfaction on the faces of volunteers as the work was completed on time.

















Survey was done to find and understand the basic problem and needs of the villagers. There was a good interaction with the villagers by the volunteers. During survey NSS volunteers got very useful information regarding education, sanitation, anganwadis, religious places, play grounds for children, major health problems in the village etc. At the end of the first day, team gathered and discussed about the day's activity and result of the survey.

Day 2: Fit India, cleanliness drive and stop food waste and nutrition rally

The day 2 of NSS camp in Gana comprised of various programmes like NSS song, NSS clap followed by Fit India Programme under which the volunteers performed various exercises like *pranayam, alom vilom, kapalbhati*. Following this, seven groups were made comprising of seven volunteers which went out on the streets of Gana village to clean the surroundings. The volunteers performed their tasks efficiently. They all were satisfied on completing their designated tasks.

After that the volunteers took slogan boards and rallied around the Gana village. The rally was regarding minimizing food waste and consumption of improved nutritious foods. Road rallies were organized on three main social issues, namely, stop food loss, food information and anti-addiction. Placards were prepared with slogans regarding food saving, nutritious food, to overcome malnutrition. The main aim of the rally was to create general awareness among the villagers. The residing people responded well.

At 12:30 PM, all the volunteers headed towards the Community Hall for lunch. After having their lunch, the volunteers assembled into their groups to play a game of "Food Related Technical Terms". The volunteers actively participated in the game along with the NSS Programme officer Dr. K.V. Vala and Piyush Moradiya. The day was pretty satisfactorily summed up as all the tasks were completed in designated time.



















Day 3: Fit India, avoid use of plastic rally, plastic collection and paryavaran bachavo

The day 3 of the camp started with NSS Song, NSS clap followed by Fit India Pogramme under which the volunteers performed various exercises like suryanamaskar, strectching. The cleanliness drive in Village Street organized. Volunteers went out on the streets of the village to clean the surroundings. After that the volunteers took slogan boards and rallied around the Gana village. The rally was regarding minimizing the use of plastic.

In afternoon, the volunteers assembled into their groups to play a game of "Talent Show". The volunteers actively participated in the game along with the NSS Programme officer. The students took the responsibility of cleaning up the "Community hall" and did the watering to existing trees/plant for the green environment. The day was pretty satisfactorily summed up as all the tasks were completed in designated time.





Day 4: Playing games with primary and secondary school students and celebration of international woman day

The day 4 was 8th March which is celebrating as International Woman's Day. After NSS Song and clap followed by Fit India exercise by girl volunteers. After that on the occasion of International Women's Day one of the volunteers, Riya Chaudhary delivered a speech.

Then the volunteers headed to K.D. Patel Vidhyamandir, a primary schoool. Where school students played various games like Musical Chairs, Balloon blast, Sac race, Pair race. The winners of the games were awarded by the prizes. After lunch discussion held for the further activity. At 15:0h

all volunteers reached secondary school. Here, classes of ninth and eleventh were involved in "Quiz Competition" and "Drawing Competition" on the topic of Women Empowerment. Then the prizes distribution to first and second winner by the lady teacher of the school. A vote of thanks was conducted at the end. The day ended satisfactorily.

















Day 5: Corona awareness rally, street play and graffiti

Day started with NSS song, NSS clap followed by Fit India Programme under which the volunteers performed Yoga like kapalbhati, alom-vilom and brahmi. After that, a rally was headed towards the different areas of the village regarding Corona Awareness. The main aim of the rally was to create the awareness among the people in order to prevent the spread of corona virus by taking appropriate safety protocols. The volunteers took up slogan boards and chanted the slogans to make the residents aware about the same.

After successful completion of rally, NSS volunteers moved towards for wall painting in different areas of Gana village. Volunteers were divided into different groups and performed the task of wall painting successfully. After the completion of wall painting programme, some of the NSS volunteers performed the drama based on "Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao" and "Nashamukti" on the streets of Gana village near main entrance of the village. After the completion of all the programs, all the volunteers moved to the Patidar Community hall for lunch. Afternoon all the volunteers moved back for wall painting. Day 6: Rally, street play and plantation

After that, the NSS volunteers headed for a rally on the topic of "Save the Environment" and made the citizens of Gana village aware about Global warming, Cleanliness and Pollution. After that the volunteers completed the wall paintings on the topic of "Save Water" and "Save Environment". Then the students headed for lunch at 1:00 pm.

After the lunch break NSS Volunteers had delivered speeches on several social topics. Najmin Malek had prepared a speech on "Food Awareness and Food Loss", Ujjwal Dhodia on "My village,

Day 7: Valedictory

The valedictory function of the special camp was organized on the last day of the camp, i.e. on 11th March, 2022 in Patidar community hall. In the valedictory function, Dr. D.H. Patel, Director, Students' welfare; Dr. S. S. Kapdi, Professor and Head, College of FPTBE AAU, Anand remained present. Village Sarpanch, Chairman of milk cooperative and other progressive farmers were invited and remained present. Before starting of the function a plantation was done by the Dr. D.H.

Patel, Dr. S.S. Kapdi & others in premises of the community hall. Valedictory function started with the lighting of lamp followed by Sara Swati Vandana and welcome of the dignitaries. Priyanshi Patel, a volunteer read out the detail report of the activities done during special camp. Other volunteer also shared/expressed their experience. After that Dr. S. S. Kapdi, explained them how NSS is useful in our day to day life. Chief Guest of the programme, Dr. D.H.
