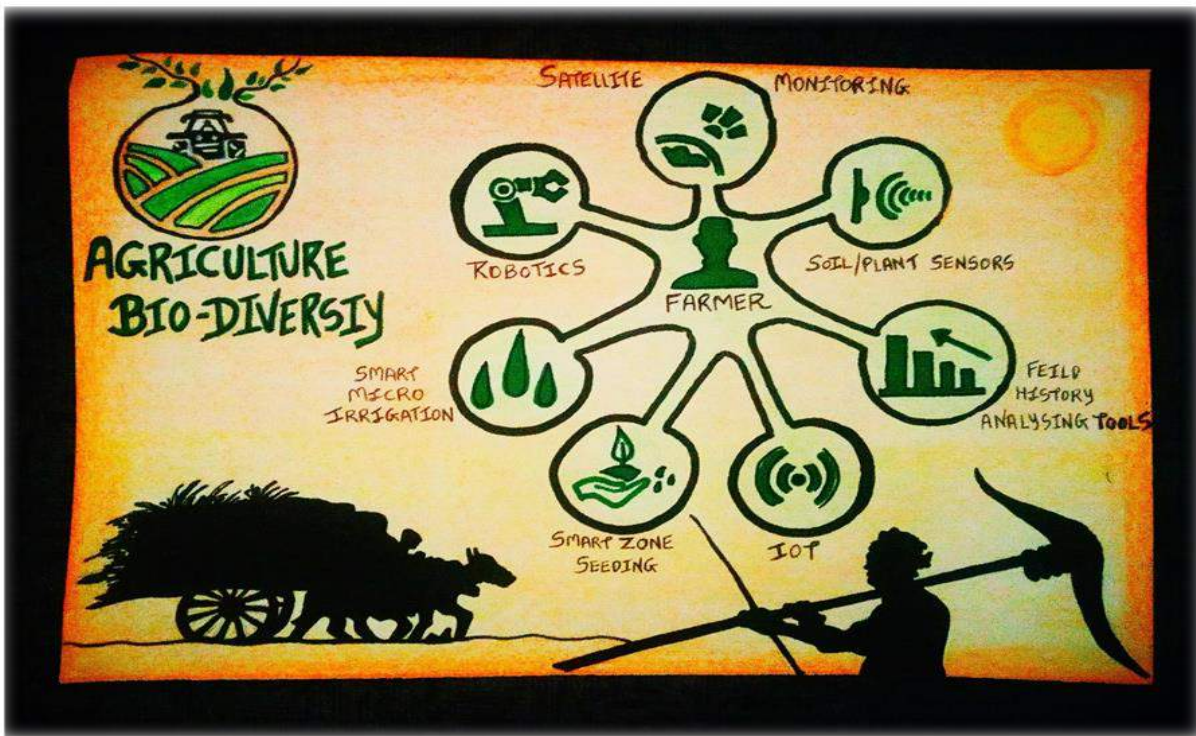
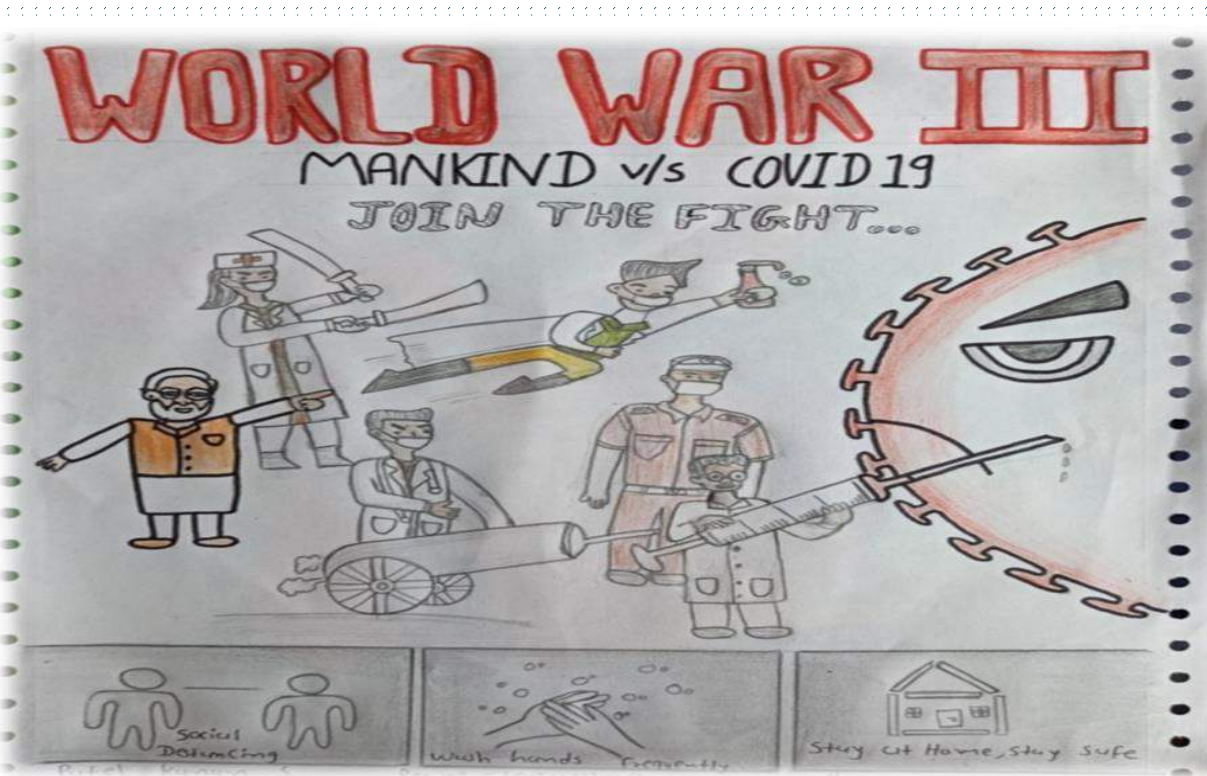
Teachers day celebration

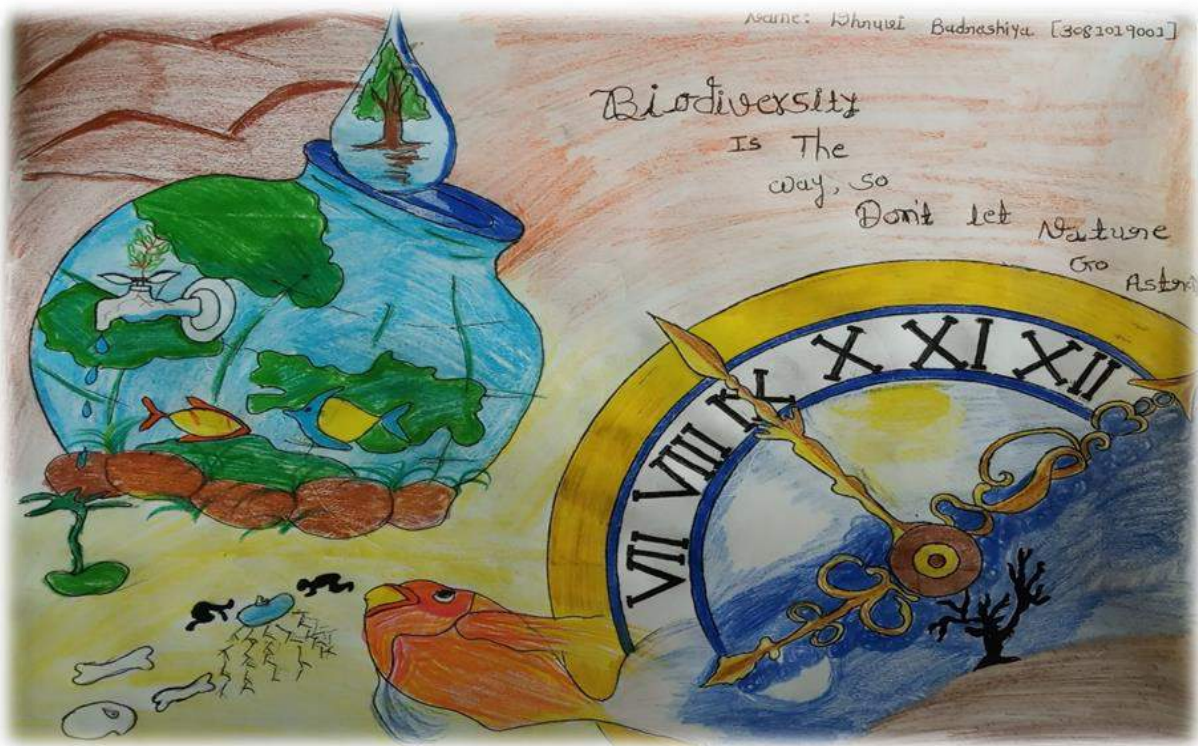

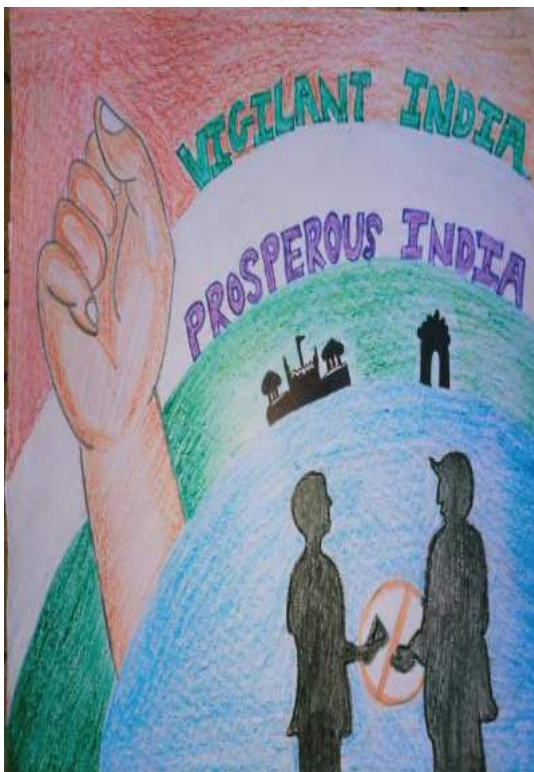

Three-days “Personality Development Training Programme

Three days Personality Development Training Programme for college of Horticulture was organized by Training and Placement Cell of College Horticulture, Anand Agricultural University, Anand during January, 20-22, 2022. Three days Personality Development Training Programme was started with Introduction of the programme by the facilitator Ms. Nitu Singh Bhadhoria, Career Counselling Expert and hypnotherapist from Vadodara. The programme was attended by 59 students of eight semester.

In three days training programme various topics was covered by facilitator, such as Building of self confidence in students, Goal settings and planning, Resume writings, dressing etiquettes for interview, E-mail etiquettes, Group discussion skills, Communication skills, Mock interview, Public speaking, Time management, Tips to face interview, Presentation skills, Advance communication skills, Interpersonal skills, Different ice breaking activities etc. At the end of each day summarizing and concluding session was also conducted.

Day 1

There was an ice breaking session first where an activity was given to students to speak a word with other students' name and they had to tell another related to that repeating the process. In this session also carried out activity of student's strengths and weakness then discuss it. Activity on introvert and an extrovert. What it truly means and that it is not bad to be an introvert or extrovert. In this activity also told to students to take positive feedback of people along with negative so that we can know our strengths along with weaknesses. Related to this topic another topic of self-confidence was also addressed.

Then the next session was on how to write a resume. She told us the contents of resume and taught us every single point in detail. She explained us the do's and don'ts of resume writing. And what was the difference between resume, CV and biodata. Then in afternoon session we were taught on how to write emails and what are email etiquettes.

Day 2

The session began with group discussion. Several topics were given and mam rectified to students in between and told to them don'ts and do's in GD. It was the most fun activity in the whole session. Everyone were involved actively and the experience was too good.

Next activity on how to appear in interview. How to practice confidence was taught? How to student's posture should be, how should we dress, how we should sit in interview were explained in detail.

Day 3

On this day a session on effective communication. For this purpose, three examples where effective communication didn't happen. She solved participated problems and made us clear with the whole topic of communication. Then activity on goal setting and how it should be planned. What must be different kinds of goals and how it must be accomplished was taught. In this session students recapped what we had learnt before. Then there was a session on time management. Then there was a question session where we can ask any questions where we had problem and discuss about.

The entire program ended with the closing ceremony again graced by Principal and Dean, College of Horticulture, Dr. N.I. Shah and Dr. A. H. Barad, Assistant Professor and In-charge T & P Cell. All the students which had attended the program in these three days tried to shear their stage fear by giving feedback in front of the audience. The ceremony ended with In-charge T & P Cell giving the vote of thanks.
