- The meeting commenced with the Chairperson reviewing the action points from the

   Some pending actions, such as streamlining feedback collection from stakeholders,
  were identified for immediate attention.
- The IQAC members discussed about the collection of data regarding the number of awards received for research or innovation for NAAC Accreditation and NIRF – Ranking. All the Deans and Unit Officers were advised to collect the data from their respective colleges or Units submit the data in a set format as early as possible.
- The committee reviewed and acknowledged the recent community outreach programs,
  particularly those involving farmer training and children health at healthcare centre,
  The IQAC members emphasized on enhancing student participation in community
  service programs to instill a sense of social responsibility.
- The committee overviewed the approved green initiatives such as rainwater harvesting systems, installation of solar panels to reduce the electricity dependency, waste segregation and increased tree plantations to reduce the campus's carbon footprint.
