




28th June-2021



A special NSS camp was organize by the Sheth M. C. Polytechnic in Agriculture, Anand Agricultural University, Anand for about 7 days in Dharmaj village, Ta: Petlad, Dis: Anand. The NSS Camp is held from 2 to 8 March, 2022. The special attention was given to arrange the program according to the government guidance based on *Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav*to perform five *prakalp*. Total 39 Volunteers were involved in this NSS special camp and by their hard work many activities were performed for the development of society. The objective is to make the volunteer a responsible citizen of India and to make others aware about the importance of responsibility that they have towards their community, society and country.

Objectives of Camp:-

The very first objective of the camp is to make the NSS volunteers realized the importance of development of society not only from the economical point of view but also the mental health and social status development and for that helping the people for attaining the overall development. The NSS special camp was aimed to develop feeling of "NOT ME BUT YOU". The Objectives of the camp is to change the mentality of people and making the society a happy/safe place to live. During the camp, focused was given on all the awful activities of the society and make effort to change environment. Focused was also given on making a good place for women, children and old aged people to live happily in the society. During the camp, the NSS volunteers i.e. youth of India showed the problem of society such as Poverty, Climate change, Unemployment, Gender inequality, Homelessness, Pollution obesity, Drug abuse, Discrimination, water scarcity, Corruption, Crime, Domestic violence, Alcoholism, Childhood obesity and much more and try to fight against it. The aim is to inbuilt the good quality within themselves that stays with them forever such Politeness, Strength to fight against wrong thing happen in society, and to increase kindness, loyalty and faithfulness.

Day-1 (Dt. 02/03/2022) - SwachchhtaAbhiyan at JalaramMandir

On 2nd March, 2022, the NSS volunteers of Sheth M. C. polytechnic in Agriculture reached the Jalaram Trust, Dharmaj. On this topic, focused on increasing the facility of education to girl child as well as to give the opportunity to girls to develop their unique skills.
