SPECIAL CAMP - 25<sup>th</sup> March to 31<sup>th</sup> March, 2018



College of Horticulture, Anand Agricultural University, Anand organized a special camp of NSS Volunteers at village Gopalpura, Ta. Anand, Dist. Anand during 25/03/2018 to 31/03/2018. Total 54 students were participated in this special camp.

During this special camp occasion, on 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 in morning session in village socio economic survey was carried out with the "Sarpanch" of Gopalpura village, Smt. Vidhyaben Patel. During survey students were familiar with the village people, got the information regarding the ratio of the community in the village and facilities available in village like Milk co-operative society, primary school, Panchayat office, Bank etc. They briefly got information regarding farmers land holding, live stock, cropping pattern and average income. After the survey of village our NSS volunteers interacted with school children and got information regarding their educational and living standard. In this session Mrs. Shalinaben Patel, Principal of Primary School helps the NSS volunteers. By this way our NSS volunteers were familiar with school children also. Then under "Swachh Bharat Abhiyan" the work was started for cleanliness of the village, In this programme NSS volunteers collect the garbage and specially all the plastic waste from all the streets and surrounding areas of the village.

Second day there was a poster making competition on theme "*Beti Bachao Beti Padhao*" and "*Save water*" after that volunteer arranges a Relly on "*Vyasan Mukti Abhiyan*".

On third day "Snake Show" was arranged with students of primary school of village. Mr. Dhaval Patel and other staff of Nature Club, Vidhyanagar joined us in the camp. They gave information on different types of snakes & cobras. Moreover they described in detail about different between poisonous and non-poisonous snakes. What should be the first aid treatment when snake bite and which types of precautions should be take when snake bites. After that programme on preparation of "Sparrow House" was initiated and NSS volunteers distributed this sparrow house at proper place in village. A two minute game on "allocation" was frame out in camp. In afternoon session volunteers visited water and land management institute (WALMI) near Hadgud village. Mr.Mehul Patel highlighted the water scenario and status of

water in Gujarat and India. Further, they explained how to conserve water; water harvesting and how individual can help in saving of water for future generation.

On 28<sup>th</sup> March, volunteers visited “Narayan dairy farm”. The owner Shri Sanjaybhai Rabari explained how we can do dairy business and what precaution should be required for increasing milk production. In afternoon session in camp there was an activity of preparation of milk products. Dr.Amit Patel and faculties of Dairy Science College joined with us in the camp. They practically guide the NSS volunteers and specially women of village how to prepare “Gulab Jamun” and “Panner” from milk and explained different uses of byproducts of milk.

On 29<sup>th</sup> March tree plantation was done in nearby area of temple, school and surrounding area of village. During the special activities camp, various other activities were also carried out *viz.* quiz competition, visited Roses Nursery, Sayaji garden at Vadodara and Sardar Patel Memorial at Karamsad.

On 31<sup>st</sup> March in closing ceremony in Special Camp with blessings by Dr.H.C.Patel Principal, College of Horticulture, Dr.K.P.Patel, Dean, B.A. College of Agriculture, Dr. S.H. Akbari, Director of Student welfare, Dr.N.I.Shah, Professor and Head, Department of Horticulture, Smt.Vidhyaben Patel, Sarpanch of the village and other faculty members of College of Horticulture were present. On this occasion, Dr.H.C.Patel, Principal, College of Horticulture motivated and informed the NSS volunteers about the thrust areas of NSS, particularly for environment conservation & enrichment, social harmony and national integration. Dr. S.H. Akbari, DSW, briefly explained about the importance of NSS in educational institutions and role of students in Nation building. Dr.K.P. Patel, Dean (BACA) also motivated the students. A detailed plan of the different activities conducted during the camp was presented by NSS volunteers.
