“First Aid and CPR Training”

On December 9, 2023, the NSS Cell of College of Horticulture, in collaboration with the Youth Red Cross Society, successfully organized a Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid Training Program. The initiative, guided by Dr. N. I. Shah, Principal & Dean, aimed to equip students with essential life-saving skills, focusing on emergency medical techniques and procedures. The program began with a welcome address from Dr. Prity Kumari, Program Officer, College of Horticulture, emphasizing the importance of first aid knowledge. Bhavini Patel, an instructor from the Youth Red Cross, introduced the concept of first aid, followed by Naynesh Bhai, who detailed the steps for handling emergencies, including the DRABC (Danger, Response, Airway, Breathing and Circulation) protocol. A practical session led by Naynesh Bhai allowed the 120 participating students from the first, third, and fifth semesters to practice and demonstrate the skills they learned. The program concluded with the Youth Red Cross Society distributing certificates to all participants, recognizing their participation and newly acquired skills in first aid and CPR. This collaborative effort between the NSS Cell and the Youth Red Cross Society not only provided practical knowledge but also raised a sense of responsibility among the students, preparing them to effectively manage emergency situations.
