

Commencement of 6th Training cum Coaching Programme for ICAR NET

As approved by Department of Agriculture and Cooperation, Govt. of Gujarat, after the successful completion of five programmes, the 6th Training cum Coaching Programme for ICAR National Eligibility Test (NET) has been commenced on 9th September, 2018 at the seminar room of College of Food Processing Technology & Bio Energy, Anand Agricultural University, Anand. In this phase, the coaching will be provided to 196 eligible candidates applied for 12 subjects, namely, Agronomy, Soil Sciences, Agricultural Extension, Genetics & Plant Breeding, Agricultural Business Management, Land and Water Management Engineering, Agricultural Entomology, Vegetable Science, Agricultural Structure & Process Engineering, Food Technology, Plant Pathology and Dairy Microbiology, in nineteen departments/centres of Anand Agricultural University, Sardarkrushinagar Dantiwada Agricultural University and Junagadh Agricultural University.
