In exercise of the power vested in Section 20(1) (xxv) of the Gujarat Agricultural Universities Act, 2004 (Gujarat Act No. 5 of 2004) the Board of Management hereby institutes a prize in the name of "Late Shri K.K. Shukla Medal" and approves following Regulations governing the said prize as recommended by the Academic Council.

Regulations governing Late Shri K.K. Shukla Medal

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| 1. | Name of the prize shall be "LATE SHRI K.K. SHUKLA MEDAL" | Name |
| 2. | The amount of endowment of Rs. 25,000/- received from the donor shall suitably be invested by the Comptroller in the form of fixed deposit in any nationalized Bank. | Endowment |
| 3. | The annual realization of the endowment shall be credited to the "University Fund". The Medal shall be awarded annually from the annual interest realized. | |
| 4. | The prize shall be awarded every year to Post Graduate student for best P. G. Research work from subjects of faculty of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry after completion of his/her Post Graduate study during a block period of one year i.e. Thesis submitted between January to December. | Eligibility |
| 5. | The prize shall be awarded in the form of a Gold Plated Silver Medal engraved with the words "LATE SHRI K.K. SHUKLA MEDAL" | Form of the prize |
| 6. | <p>(1) The Registrar shall prepare the list of students who successfully completed the course of M. V. Sc. at Anand Agricultural University who fulfill the condition mentioned in 4 above and shall present the same to the committee constituted to decide the awardee.</p> <p>(2) Following committee shall decide the awardee for the Late Shri K.K. Shukla Medal taking into consideration the professors' committee constituted as in 9 (2) the evaluation of eligible thesis(s)</p> <p>(a) Dean, P.G. | 8. | The endowment shall suitably be incorporated in the annual report of the Anand Agricultural University. | |

9. The selection procedure is as under

- (1) Each P.G. student who completes his/her study with OGPA 7.00/10.00 or higher will be considered for the award. The approved thesis of such candidates shall be evaluated as under for total score of 100 as per the following table
- (2) The Vice Chancellor as per recommendations of the Dean will nominate the committee of three professors of the faculty for evaluation all the thesis(s) of the qualified candidates as in 9 (1). The student candidate getting highest points as per (2) will be awarded the Medal, on recommendation and approval by the Selection Committee.
In the period of every year the students who have completed Master or Doctorate study shall be ranked on the basis of above evaluation procedure and top ranking student will be awarded the Medal.
