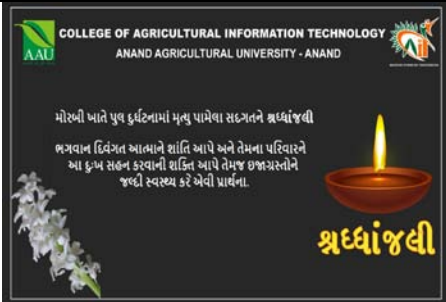

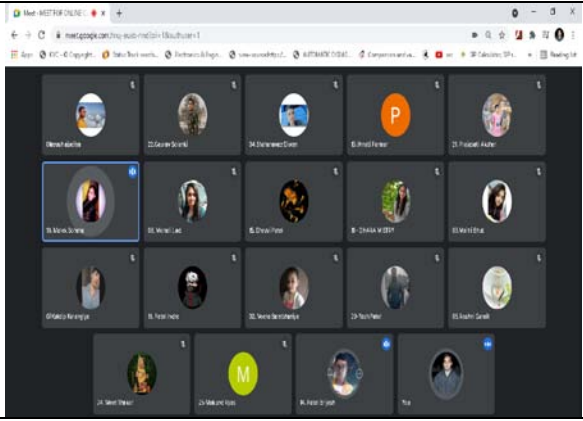

## Day 1-25/02/2023-Saturday

The Seven days night staying camp started on 25th of February 2023, by college of AIT, Anand at Dharmaj village of Anand District. At 3pm we reached Jalaram Tirth, the NSS volunteers were given stay at the main hall in the temple. They started with cleaning the place where they stayed. All made themselves comfortable and then went for Aarti at Jalaram Temple. Everyone had prashadi, then served food at temple. After that, all got gathered at a place then we introduced ourselves with each other. Students performed the different acts on topics like, Cyber Security, Road Safety, Healthy environment and Quit addiction.



The fresh start of day was with yoga. Yoga is an excellent approach to improve your flexibility and strength. Road safety related lecture about importance of license, documents, over-speeding was given by Chaudhari Sir and Hadda Sir.



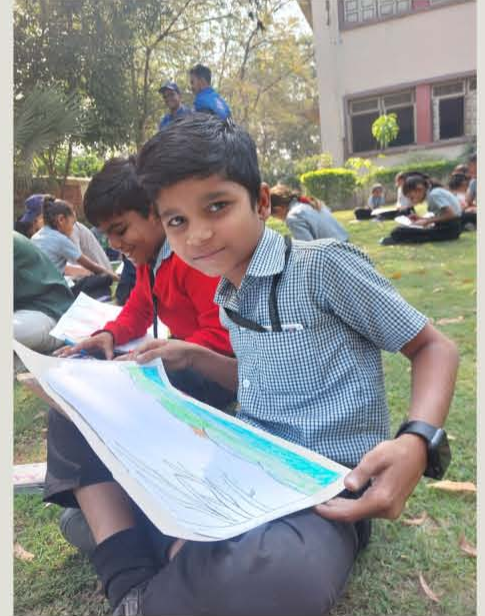
