SRC Activities of College of Food Processing Technology & Bio Energy Year 2019-20

1. Orientation Programme

The college admitted its 11th batch of undergraduate students and 15th batch of post graduate students for academic session of 2019-20. To acquaint new students regarding various facts of the college programme, facilities available at different laboratories and pilot plant units, a one day orientation programme was organized Dr. Govind P.Tagalapplewar Chairman, SRC on September 03, 2019. The introductory session was attended by all the faculty members and students whereby introduction of all the teachers and students was done along with a presentation by the Dr.R.F.Sutar, Principal and Dean of the college on Food Processing Technology in general.

The presentations by Heads of Department were done highlighting activities of each department of the college. The students were also appraised about the college/hostel's rules and regulations and different SRC and NSS activities. A visit to central library of the university was arranged where functioning of library was discussed along with rules and regulations for use of e-library and cybrary along with visit to various laboratories of the college, biodiesel plant, experiential learning unit (ELU) of the college for the first year B.Tech. (FT) students.

2. Technical Events

A) National Level Award: National Dairy Products' Judging Contest & National Dairy and Food Quiz Contest

Alumni Association of S.M.C College of Dairy Science, AAU, Anand has organized the 16th National Dairy Products' Judging Contest & 12th National Dairy and Food Quiz Contest on 6-7 September, 2019. Thirteen teams from Dairy Industry and thirteen teams from Academic Institutes participated in the dairy products judging contest. Three different products namely Milk, Shrikhand and Processed cheese were presented to the team mates for sensory analysis. In National Dairy Products' Judging Contest Mr. Ansh S. Patel and Mr. Dhruv Patel 4th Year students of B.Tech (FPT) were participated and the team was lead by Prof.R.B Modi as Team manager.

C) Organization of ADROIT'19: A National Technical Festival

As part of the celebration, around 500 participating students were provided with hands-on-experience on the state-of-art machinery installed in the Food Processing Incubation Centre and Experiential Learning Unit (ELU) of the college, comprising of eight small scale food processing plants including frying line for production of fried snacks, food extrusion line for production of extruded products like corn balls, flakes and core filled products, dehydration line, canning line for processing of fruit pulps, juice bottling line, fresh fruits and vegetables handling line, individual quick freezing line (IQF) and bakery line for the production of bread, bun, biscuit and pizza, etc. An interactive session was also organized between invited reputed industry and academic people with the participants on the theme of "Single-Use Plastic Ban: Issues and Challenges to Food Industry". World Food Day awareness rally, with more than 500 students and faculties, were also organized in the twin city of Anand – Vallabh Vidyanagar.

B) Inter university Table tennis & Cricket event:

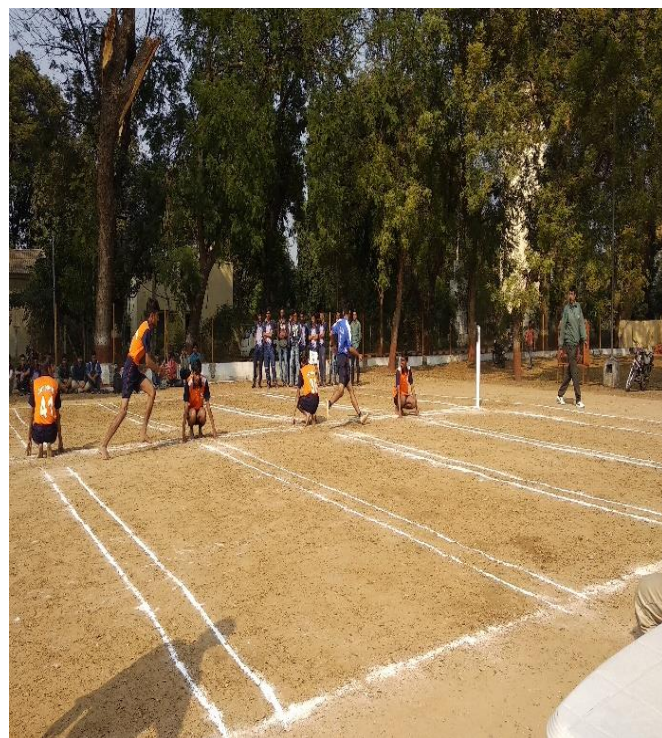
