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
#### E) World Food Day Celebration (National Tech Fest – Adroit, 23):

World Food Day is celebrated every year around the world on 16<sup>th</sup> October, to mark the foundation day of the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) of the United Nations. In line with this tradition, College of Food Processing Technology & Bio Energy, Anand Agricultural University, Anand in collaboration with the FPT & BE Alumni Association, AAU Incubation Centre (AIC), FDCA and AFSTi, celebrated World Food Day by hosting a two-day National Tech Fest called "ADROIT' 23" with the theme "Water is life, water is food. Leave no one behind." It is all about bringing new perspectives towards the field of Food Processing by encouraging infinite potential of budding technocrats to Conceive, Create & Conquer.

"ADROIT" serves as a platform where emerging food technocrats can exhibit their innovations and validate their exceptional talent and skills.
