#### 3. Summer training evaluation (ABM-595)

Student's advisory committee will evaluate summer training project using standard format consisting of 100 marks. The students obtaining 60% or above marks (Average of marks awarded by all evaluation committee members) will be given satisfactory grade (S) and those obtaining less than 60% will be given Unsatisfactory grade (US).

#### 4. Project work evaluation (ABM-599)

The evaluation committee which comprises four members namely, Project Chairman (Major Guide), one associated faculty from recognized PG teachers, one faculty (recognized PG teacher) nominated by Dean PGS and one external expert (Company/SAUs/Other organizations) as per the Common P.G. Regulation No. 44.5 (2022-23) will evaluate the project work using standard format consisting of 100 marks. The students obtaining 60% or above marks (Average of marks awarded by all evaluation committee members) will be given satisfactory grade (S) and those obtaining less than 60% will be given Unsatisfactory grade (US).

# 5. Clarification regarding Common P.G. Regulation No. 39.3.2 (2022-23)

Summer Internship of 4 Credit (ABM -595) and Project work of 10 Credit (ABM -599) will be evaluated through Satisfactory(S) / Unsatisfactory (US) grade. While remaining 16 credit Preparatory courses will be evaluated through grade point system.
