Annexure-A

ANAND AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY BEST TEACHER AWARD IN AGRICULTURAL HIGHER EDUCATION

To provide incentive and encouragement for good teaching and to recognize outstanding teachers at the university level, one Best Teacher Award will be given every year for an excellent teaching performance amongst all faculties of AAU.

Name of the Award: Best Teacher Award in Agricultural Higher Education

The award will be presented to one faculty member among all the faculties of Anand Agricultural University. The award is primarily meant for individual teacher independently teaching a course or part of an integrated course.

Nature of Award

The Best Teacher Award shall be annual. The Award will carry a cash prizes of ₹.25,000/- [to be incurred from the Interest of B.H. 9512 (Institutional Charges)] with a certificate and will be instituted by Anand Agricultural University.

Administration of the Award

The award in each Higher Agricultural Education Institute (HAEI) will be coordinated by Dean (P.G. Studies). The applications will be invited by the Coordinator, which will be submitted through HoD/Principal to the Principal/Dean. The Dean of the Faculty after having nomination from different departments as per **Annexure-B**, will forward only one name to the Coordinator. The Coordinator will receive the nominations from all the Deans which will be checked and verified by the Screening committee to be nominated by the Vice Chancellor. The judging committee will consider the name of applicant having overall cut-off of 65 marks. All nominations from each faculty after the scrutiny by the screening committee will be submitted to the Judgment Committee for the final selection of the Awardee, and will be put to Board of Management for Approval. No appeal against the decision will be entertained.

Academic year

Academic year will be considered from August to July or as defined of respective year.

Eligibility of the Award

The applicant must have at least 5 years of teaching/research/extension experience in AAU as a regular faculty member barring Principal/Dean. The applications/proposals will be invited by the Coordinator every year. The application/proposals in prescribed format will be enrooted through proper channel. **The work done during the past 5 years only will be considered for the award.** The candidate once selected for the award (in past as per the prevailing norms) will not be eligible for the award for the next five years.

The candidate must have at least three 'Very Good' overall rating in annual appraisal/self-appraisal reports out of immediate past five reports. The candidate is expected to be a role model teacher with high moral values and must not have been penalized or any enquiry pending against him/her.

The judgment committee will be as follows

3.	Deans/Directors (Existing/retired) from other agricultural Universities/Institutes nominated by the Vice Chancellor	One

5.	Coordinator (Dean, P.G. Studies)	Member Secretary

Presentation of Awards

The Best Teacher Award in Agricultural Higher Education shall include certificate with a cheque of ₹. 25,000/- as Cash Prize. It will be awarded during the immediate subsequent Annual Convocation of the University.
