





AIC Anand hosted the "A 10-Day 'Startup Anand' Workshop Series in the Spirit of National Startup Day.

In the spirit of India's 'National Startup Day, Anand Agricultural University's Incubation Center '**AIC Anand**', initiated the 'Startup Anand' Workshop Series'. The 10-day-long event from 16 to 30 January 2024 fosters an entrepreneurial spirit among the youth through a series of engaging activities, workshops, and events.

Starting with the 'Startup Support Awarding Ceremony' on day 1, Seven successful agri-startups were awarded funding support of ₹59 lakh under the RKVY RAFTAAR Agribusiness Incubator project of Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare, Govt. of India. Dr. K. B. Kathiria, Hon. Vice Chancellor, AAU, released the first grant installment to startups. Followed by an Inaugural session for the Prasoon-Startup Agribusiness Incubation program and Pallav-Agriprenurship orientation program, where 40 incubatees began their 2-month comprehensive agripreneurship training.

An **AAU Stakeholders meeting** was also organized under the chairmanship of Hon. Vice Chancellor, AAU, gathering over 30 participants, including University officers, Principals, Deans, Faculty members, and ELU coordinators of various colleges of AAU. **Dr. M. K. Jhala**, Director of Research, AAU addressed the meeting and initiated the discussions on strengthening the Startup ecosystem in AAU. All attendees actively contributed their suggestions during the session.

On day 2, A 'Mind 2 Market' Workshop was conducted by Shri Ravin Bhadja, Founder, FindmyFactory.com, he highlighted the significance of market research and strategies to overcome challenges in bringing ideas to market.

On day 3, **Shri Nitin Mistry**, Author & Startup coach, conducted a '**Pitch Deck Preparation Workshop**'. He inspired participants to make effective pitches for business funding.

On day 4, '**Brainstorming & Idea Validation Workshop** was led by **Shri Nikunj Soni**, CEO, AIC Anand, concentrating on establishing a peer-learning atmosphere and seeking feedback for idea validation from entrepreneurial minds.

On day 5, an exposure visit to the **Amul** Dairy Plant, AAU's **Bio-Fertilizer** unit, and **Tissue Culture Lab** was arranged for participants.

On day 6, A **Mentor Matching Session** was organized for Startups where entrepreneurs presented their business ideas and the challenges they are facing before an esteemed panel comprising **Dr. Samit Dutta**, Dean, CFPTBE, AAU, **Dr. N. I. Shah**, Dean, College of Horticulture, **Dr. R. S. Pundir**, Dean, IABMI, **Dr. S.H. Akbari**, HoD, FPO, CFPTBE, AAU & **Dr. H. Pandey**, HoD, FPT, CFPTBE, AAU.

On day 7, Shri Chandrakant Patel, an Independent Consultant, and Shri Nirmesh Patel, Custom Operation Manager, facilitated an 'Export and Import Workshop'. They shared their experiences and provided practical guidance on export and import procedures, including customs clearance for agrifood exports to the participants.

On day 8, **Shri Anand Bhatnagar**, A renowned TEDx Speaker & and VP at a leading conglomerate was invited to deliver a motivational talk titled **'Start Unknown, Finish Unforgettable'**. As it was National Girl Child Day, along with 40 Startup Entrepreneurs and 25 female students from College of Horticulture, AAU was also invited to participate in the program.

Dr. Vishal Joshi, Director, Biomer Advanced Materials Pvt. Ltd., conducted a '**Design Thinking Workshop**' for Startups highlighting that Problem-solving is a key skill that everyone should master.

On day 9, Shri Amit Panchal, Founder, Digicobweb conducted a workshop on 'Digital Marketing Basics'. He guided participants about utilizing various digital platforms for enhanced product visibility.

On the eve of Republic Day, the celebrations were also held at AIC Anand in attendance of **Dr**. **Samit Dutta**, Dean, CFPTBE, AAU, **Dr. H. Pandey**, HoD, FPT, CFPTBE, AAU, Team AIC Anand along with 40+ Startup Founders.
