It is hereby notified to all concerned that the 58th Meeting of Board of Management held on 27-07-2023 has resolved as under vide Item No. 58.32:

"It is resolved that the Board of Management accord approval of guidelines/conditions and implementation of payment of publication charges as mentioned below to be sanctioned for postgraduate research and final year undergraduate students of Anand Agricultural University as recommended by 15th Agricultural Research Council vide item No. 15.11"

- 1. Any PG student of AAU and UG student of AAU (Final Year) can apply for publication charges for research publications through his/her Major Guide or Mentor, respectively. The Major Guide/Mentor can also apply for the same. However, PG student availing SHODH scholarship, ICAR Fellowship or any such scholarship/Fellowship in which contingency grant is provided for research publication would not be eligible to get publication charges.
- 2. Such Postgraduate research publication can have any number of authors based on their research contribution but research scholar (student) must be the first author and guide as the second author. For UG student, the student's name will be as the first author followed by mentor/s.
- 3. The PG student/Guide/Mentor can claim this benefit with following upper limit.
 - UG student of AAU (Final Year) one publication/year (Maximum)
 - M.Sc./M.Tech./M.B.A. Student one publication from PG research (Maximum)
 - Ph.D. Student two publications from doctoral research (Maximum)
- 4. In case of UG research publication, following upper limit of students per year must be followed (approximately 10 % of the intake).

- Research journal should have NAAS rating 5.00 or above. For basic science and other concerned discipline where NAAS rating is not available, Impact Factor (Thomson Reuters) 0.05 will be considered.
- The upper ceiling of such expenditure will be Rs. 10,000/- per year for UG student of AAU (Final Year) and Master's student, and Rs. 20,000/- for Ph.D. Student of AAU per year for plan schemes.
- 7 The expenditure may be sanctioned in DBT/DST/GOI/ICAR funded project, if there is a provision for publication expense in such project grants.
- 8 If saving is available at the end of completion of private company projects, University may permit for the said expenditure.
